Images can be in landscape or portrait orientation, or a combination of both. Your panel may consist entirely of colour images, monochrome images, or a mix of the two.

Panels will be evaluated by our club judges—Peter, Andy, and Jane—and, if time allows, there will be an opportunity for feedback from attending members

## Q&A

- Can I submit one image as a triptych for the 3 images? No.
- Do the images need to be new to the club? Previous seen images at the club can be used in your panel.
- Format for Print Images? Standard print images on a pre-cut 50 by 40 cm mount (see next point).
- Do I have to use pre-cut 50 by 40 cm mount boards? No, you can mount your images onto mount boards. For this occasion, the images could just be "stuck-on" to the boards.
- What's the format for the digital images in the panel? Standard projected images as per club events.
- Can I use the images in any future competition? "Yes", providing the images have not been seen in any previous club competition.
