- Members for each team have been selected randomly out of the hat.
- This is an "Open DPI club fun event", no set-subject, however, the image(s) should not have been used in any previous Barnstaple Club competition or fun event).
- Your image could be a straight from the camera shot, manipulated, creative in the camera or with software, or both, mono, colour or colour popping acceptable. Clip art, or any part of the image, that was not photograph by the member, including AI cloud generation pixels, cannot be used.
- The images will be critique and judged. Scoring of each image will be out of 20 points.
- The team with the highest score is the winning team all good fun!

The following rules apply for each team:

- \square Total number of images from each group = $\frac{16}{10}$ images.
- Only one team member may enter a maximum of three images.
- All members of the team must submit at least 1 image.
- A team co-ordinator will be selected for each team.
- Team images critique and selection to occur on the club night of the 5th December. Final hand-in date to the Competition Secretary by the 22nd December, so plenty of time to modify, change, or add additional images into your team selection pot!

Q&A.

What's the file name and format of the submitted images?

'Image Title-Mxx.jpg' e.g. The Tree House-M23.jpg. Image size is 1600 by 1200 pixels landscape, or if portrait format, maximum height of 1200. No canvas required around the image to meet the image size requirements. SRGB colour spec. Set image quality to maximum jpeg.

What happens if a team member fails to present an image?

Any team member failing to submit an image will reduce the total images/team e.g. 1 member fails, total team image = 15, 2 members fail, total team images = 14, etc...

- Who decides which members should provide additional images?
 Up to the team members.
- Who do I send my final team images to?
 WeTransfer Email or on a USB stick to Competition Secretary.
- What happens if more members join the club?
 Any new member joining the club will be allocated to one of the teams.
