Dear Friends at Saint Mark's,

As I write this letter, I am just finishing my first week as a counselor at the Hearts in Hands Summer Camp held at the Indian Run Community Center, in Glenmore. And it was a hot camp! The daily temperatures were above 95 degrees, and I expected the staff and kids there to be lethargic and hard to handle. But I was wrong. The children were delightfully cooperative and the young staff, mostly Jr. High kids, were very competent and enjoyed the kids in their care. It was as they say, a "Win, Win" for everyone.

Now, I had the honor of leading a morning prayer time and I discovered that many of the children there had no idea who God is. They were surprised when I said God's name here on earth was "Jesus". They also had no idea that they were children of God because no one told them they were, and that God never hugged them or talked to them. It struck me then, at that moment, that Christians still have a lot of work to do around Honey Brook and Glenmore.

I plan on helping at Camp in a few weeks in the July session. I hope you will consider helping engage these children on a personal level with me. Most of the camp kids are hungry for personal attention from a kind adult, even an old man like me. The St. Mary Window

The design of St. Mary holding the Christ child has many meanings incorporated into the picture. Behind the figure of the Virgin Mary is the closed gate of Ezekiel's prophecy (44:2) which states: "Then said the Lord unto me; this gate shall be shut, it shall not be opened, and no man shall enter in by it; because the Lord, the God of Isreal, hath entered in by it. Therefore it shall be shut." This is often used as a symbol of chastity. The lilies aare a symbol of virginity and purity. The dove is a symbol of peace and also purity. This window was given by McClure Kelly from Glenmoore in loving memory of his wife Theodora Kelly (1908-1964).
