Isaiah Gaitan – 2026 QB 6’ 170 –

Poised pocket awareness, good touch on deep ball, mobility to move in and out of the pocket all while keeping his head up and eyes downfield. Delivers a catchable ball with good velocity.

Davis McCray – 2026 WR/S 6’2 205 –

Plays WR/Safety. He is raw at WR but a summer working at it will benefit him greatly. He has all the attributes. Body frame, hands, quickness, and 4.5 speed

Ryan Araiza – 2025 OL/DL 5’11 250 –

Plays with a chip on his shoulder. Good first step with power and use of hands. Able to disengage and the quickness to get in the backfield. Has a good motor, plays both sides of the ball.
