## STEVE WIEST

Steve Wiest is an Associate Professor in the Jazz Studies Division of the College of Music at the University of North Texas. He directs the world-famous One O'Clock Lab Band, coordinates the lab bands, and teaches jazz conducting and trombone. Along with these duties, Steve also created and oversees the UNT jazz trombone band: "The U-Tubes", an ensemble that consists of 5-8 trombones, and full rhythm section.

Arabesque Recording artist and Grammy-nominated arranger Steve Wiest is in great demand as a featured soloist, composer/arranger and clinician. Wiest's solo CD: "Excalibur: The Steve Wiest Big Band" was released in August of 2006 by Arabesque Jazz to wide critical acclaim, and his newest release for Arabesque "Out of The New" was released in September of 2008.

From 1981-1986, Steve was the featured trombonist and one of the arrangers for Maynard Ferguson's Band. Following his years with Ferguson, Steve completed a Masters Degree in Jazz Studies at the University of North Texas. While at UNT, he was the lead trombonist and one of the featured arrangers for the UNT 1:00 Lab Band.

After a two-year stint as Assistant Director of Jazz Studies at The University of Texas at Arlington, [1988-1990], Steve became Director of Jazz Studies and Trombone at The University of Wisconsin-Whitewater. Steve was appointed Assistant Professor of Jazz Composition and Trombone at the University of North Texas in 2007, and was nominated for the *Best Instrumental Arrangement* Grammy Award for 2007 by The Recording Academy for his arrangement of *Besame Mucho* on Maynard Ferguson's "One and Only" CD. After a one-year position as Interim Director, Steve was named permanent Director of the One O'Clock Lab Band as a result of a national search in 2009.

**SARAH MCKOIN**

Dr. Sarah McKoin is the Director of Bands at Texas Tech University and Associate Professor of Music as well as Director of the Wind Ensemble at the Brevard Music Center in Brevard, North Carolina. Dr. McKoin conducts the Texas Tech University Wind Ensemble and teaches all levels of conducting and wind literature. She just completed her ninth summer in residence at the Brevard Music Center where she serves on the conducting faculty and conducts the Transylvania Wind Ensemble comprised of college-aged musicians from throughout the country.

Prior to her appointment at Texas Tech, Professor McKoin was the Director of Bands at the University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory of Music and held appointments at the State University of New York at Buffalo and SUNY Fredonia. Her UMKC Wind Symphony was selected as a featured ensemble and performed for the 2005 Missouri Music Educator’s National Association Conference. In addition, the Wind Symphony under Dr. McKoin’s leadership performed for the College Music Society’s National Conference and for the opening concert of a nationally recognized month long festival honoring Igor Stravinsky which involved all of Kansas City’s major arts organizations. While Director of Bands at the University at Buffalo, the UB Wind Ensemble was invited to perform for the New York State Band Directors’ National Association, the first invitation of its kind for that ensemble.

McKoin holds her Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the University of Texas at Austin as well as degrees from Wichita State University and Michigan State University. She is active in the College Band Director’s National Association having served as the New York state chairperson and has taught secondary school in both Michigan and at L.D. Bell High School in Texas.
