TIM ISHIT

Tim Ishii earned both his Bachelor's and Master's degrees in music from the University of North Texas. He has served on the faculties at the University of North Texas, Tarrant County College South Campus, Tarrant County College Northwest Campus, Texas Wesleyan University, and is now Director of Jazz Studies at University of Texas at Arlington.

He has gained national and international recognition as an artist/clinician and jazz educator. In January of 1995, he led a jazz quintet to Russia, where he performed and taught in Samara, Saratov, and Moscow. For the past eleven years he has served as Music Director of the Lonestar International/ Pinkpop Jazz Exchange, a cultural exchange between, Germany, Texas, and Los Angeles. In addition, Tim has taught and performed on numerous jazz camps/workshops throughout the United States alongside some of the nation's leading jazz educators and performers. He maintains a busy freelance schedule in the Dallas/Fort Worth Metroplex and is sought after as an artist and clinician.

Tim has recorded with the University of North Texas One O'clock Lab Band, Dallas Jazz Orchestra, Pete Petersen's Collection Jazz Orchestra, and the Rick Stitzel Big Band. He has also performed with the Dallas Symphony, Fort Worth Symphony, Tulsa Philharmonic, Dallas Wind Symphony, and Texas Wind Symphony. He has worked with artists such as: Natalie Cole, Clark Terry, Doc Severinsen, Ray Charles, Mel Torme, and Maureen McGovern.

ROBERT McELROY

Robert McElroy (Conductor and Artistic Director - The Houston Symphonic Band) is in demand throughout Texas and the United States for his skill, passion, and musicianship in the concert hall as well as in the classroom. His impressive career spans four decades of conducting bands, choirs and orchestras including the Band of the People's Liberation Army (People's Republic of China), the Orquestra de Camara of the University of Yucatan in Merida, Mexico, the combined bands of the Queen's Royal Army at Kneller Hall (London, England), the Fresno Wind Orchestra, the Texas Community College All-State Band, the Texas Private and Parochial School All-State Band and numerous High School and Junior High School All-Region bands in Texas and nationwide. He also served as the conductor of Houston's only professional wind ensemble-The Katy Wind Symphony.

During his long teaching career, Mr. McElroy has also served as director of Fine Arts for the Goose Creek CISD (Baytown, Texas), President of the Texas Music Educators Association (Band Division Chair, 1986-88), and as an Executive Board Member of the Texas Music Adjudicators Association. McElroy has recently completed a term as a member of the Texas Music Adjudicators Association "Standard of Adjudication and Performance Practices" Committee.

McElroy has served as Director of Instrumental Activities for HBU for the past five years. He will retire from teaching at the conclusion of the current academic year.
