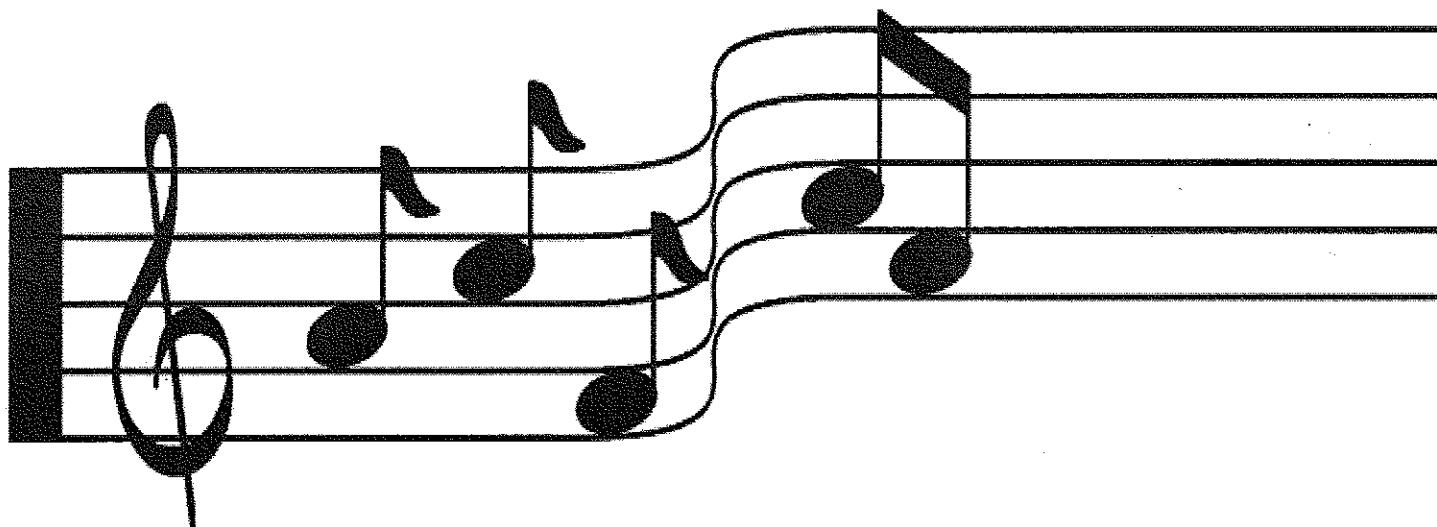

NEIL SLATER

Grammy Award nominee Neil Slater is director of the internationally-acclaimed One O'Clock Lab Band and chair of the jazz studies division at the University of North Texas. He was appointed to the College of Music faculty in 1981. In addition to creating more than 60 compositions for jazz ensembles, Slater has written for symphony, mixed chamber groups, a cappella chorus and theater. He has been recognized by the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP) each year since 1987. A pianist and former member of the Stan Kenton Orchestra-In-Residence program, Slater has recorded/performed with name artists including Buddy DeFranco, Dave Weckl, Mel Lewis and Joe Morello. Prior to his association at UNT, Slater founded the jazz studies program and established master's and bachelor's degree programs in jazz at the University of Bridgeport, (Conn.).

JAMES RIGGS

Saxophonist James Riggs serves as Regents Professor at the University of North Texas where he teaches saxophone, directs the award winning Two O'Clock Lab Band coordinates the world's largest enrollment of saxophone students. Riggs is recognized as an innovative teacher known for his insights into classical and jazz saxophone techniques and jazz improvisation. He is a recording artist and has performed regularly with the Dallas and Ft. Worth Symphony Orchestras. He performed with the Dallas Symphony on the European tour of Holland, Belgium, Switzerland, Germany, England and Ireland. He recorded Prokofiev's Lt. Kije, Gershwin's Rhapsodie in Blue, Porgy and Bass and American in Paris with the Dallas Symphony Orchestra and appeared as a jazz soloist with the United States Navy Commodores in Washington, D.C. Riggs has also conducted All-State Jazz Bands in Michigan, Ohio, Oklahoma, Kentucky and Tennessee and has appeared as a featured performer and clinician at Jazz Festivals throughout the USA and Sweden. As a freelance artist he has performed with Frank Sinatra, Ella Fitzgerald, Tony Bennett, Nancy Wilson, Henry Mancini, Nelson Riddle, Stan Kenton and others. He holds degrees from the University of North Texas and the University of Toledo. Riggs is an artist/clinician for Selmer Corporation and Rico International.

Dr. Rod Schueller

Dr. Rod Schueller is Assistant Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Texas State University-San Marcos. In this capacity, he directs the Bobcat Marching Band, the Basketball Band, the Symphonic Winds and teaches courses in the Music Education area as well as supervising student teachers. He also serves as the chief administrator of the band department.

Prior to his appointment at Texas State, Dr. Schueller held faculty appointments at Northern Illinois University and Western Illinois University. At Western Illinois, he served as Associate Director of Bands and Director of the Marching Leathernecks. He earned the Bachelor of Music degree in Trumpet Performance and Music Education from the University of Iowa, the Master of Music degree in Wind Conducting from Indiana University, and the Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Wind Conducting from Michigan State University. He has studied conducting with Ray E. Cramer and John L. Whitwell and credits Morgan Jones, John T. Madden and David Woodley as his athletic band mentors.

Dr. Schueller is a contributing author to three volumes in the *Teaching Music Through Performance in Band* series published by GIA and has published an article in *The Instrumentalist*. He holds honorary memberships in Kappa Kappa Psi, Tau Beta Sigma and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. He is currently a member of the College Band Directors National Association, the National Band Association, the College Music Society and the Texas Music Educators Association. He remains active as an adjudicator, clinician and conductor. As an arranger, his catalog includes over 100 titles for high school and college athletic bands.
