

DEB SCOTT

Deb Scott teaches trombone and bass trombone and is the director of Stephen F. Austin State University's jazz band, The Swingin' Aces. She is active as a performer and clinician in both classical and jazz styles. She is currently a member of SFA's Faculty Jazz Combo, the Longview Symphony, as well as The Orchestra of the Pines. She received her Master of Music degree from the University of Northern Colorado where she was a graduate assistant in jazz studies and directed the UNC Jazz Lab Band IV. She received her Bachelor of Music Education and Bachelor of Music in Trombone Performance from Texas Tech University. She is currently pursuing her doctorate in trombone performance at the University of North Texas and anticipates graduating this May.

Before coming to SFA, Ms. Scott was the director of the concert band and jazz band at Wharton County Jr. College and performed frequently in the Houston area as the lead trombonist for the Ronnie Renfrow Big Band and as a free-lancer in the jazz, salsa, and classical styles.

Ms. Scott has had several trombone and bass trombone etudes accepted for publication for All-State Jazz auditions in Texas. She regularly reviews CDs for the International Trombone Association Journal and contributes pedagogical information to the Texas School Music Project, tsmp.org a web site sponsored by the Stephen F. Austin State University Department of Music.

SHELLEY CARROL

Saxophonist, Shelley Carrol hails from a family or gospel singers and musicians in Houston, Texas. It was there that the music bug bit him at en early age and landed him in the famed Boys Choir of Houston. After picking up the saxophone, he was able to study with the legendary Texas Tenor greats Arnett Cobb and Don Wilkerson. At the time he didn't know how revered these gentlemen were around the globe. They simply lived in his neighborhood. Shelley attended the city's High School for the Performing and Visual Arts and was a standout in the city's Summer Jazz Workshop Program. This is where he developed a true flair for the stage.

While attending the University of North Texas, Shelley earned a spot in the Grammy Nominated One O'clock Lab Band. There he recorded two critically acclaimed CD's in 1990 - 91. During the same period, Mr. Carrrol was invited to join the Duke Ellington Orchestra by trumpeter Barry Lee Hall. This would prove to be an enormous musical opportunity with worldwide exposure. Since joining the band, he has toured the U.S. and over 30 foreign countries. He has also recorded and or performed with Maureen McGovern, Tony Bennet, Nancy Wilson, Joe Williams and a host of others. More recent credits include performances with the Benny Golson Big Band and Louie Bellson. Last summer Shelley was featured on tour with Roger Waters of Pink Floyd. His music has also been featured on prime time television shows Melrose Place and Evening Shade.

Matthew McInturf is Associate Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Sam Houston State University in Huntsville, Texas. He previously taught at Florida International University and in the public schools of Richardson, Texas.

Mr. McInturf is a doctoral candidate in conducting at the University of Cincinnati College Conservatory of Music, where he studied with Eugene Corporon. He holds a Bachelor of Music degree in Music Theory from the University of North Texas and a Master of Music in Composition from the University of Houston.

Throughout his career, Mr. McInturf's ensembles have been recognized for their musical accomplishment. He has performed throughout the United States and recordings of his performances have been broadcast on National Public Radio. In 1991, conducting the J.J. Pearce High School Band, he performed an acclaimed concert at the Mid-West Clinic, with trombone soloist Christian Lindberg.

An advocate of new music, Mr. McInturf has continued to commission new works for wind ensemble. In addition, he is a member of the Board of Directors of the World-Wide Concurrent Premiers and Commissioning Fund, Inc., a nonprofit corporation that works internationally to form consortiums to commission significant new works from contemporary composers. Mr. McInturf also serves on the National Commissioning Committee of the College Band Directors National Association.

Mr. McInturf has served as Region Officer in the Texas Music Educators Association and is a member of the board of directors of the Texas Bandmasters Association. He is active in the College Band Directors National Association and the World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles and is a member of the College Music Society. Mr. McInturf enjoys guest conducting and frequently serves as a clinician and adjudicator.
