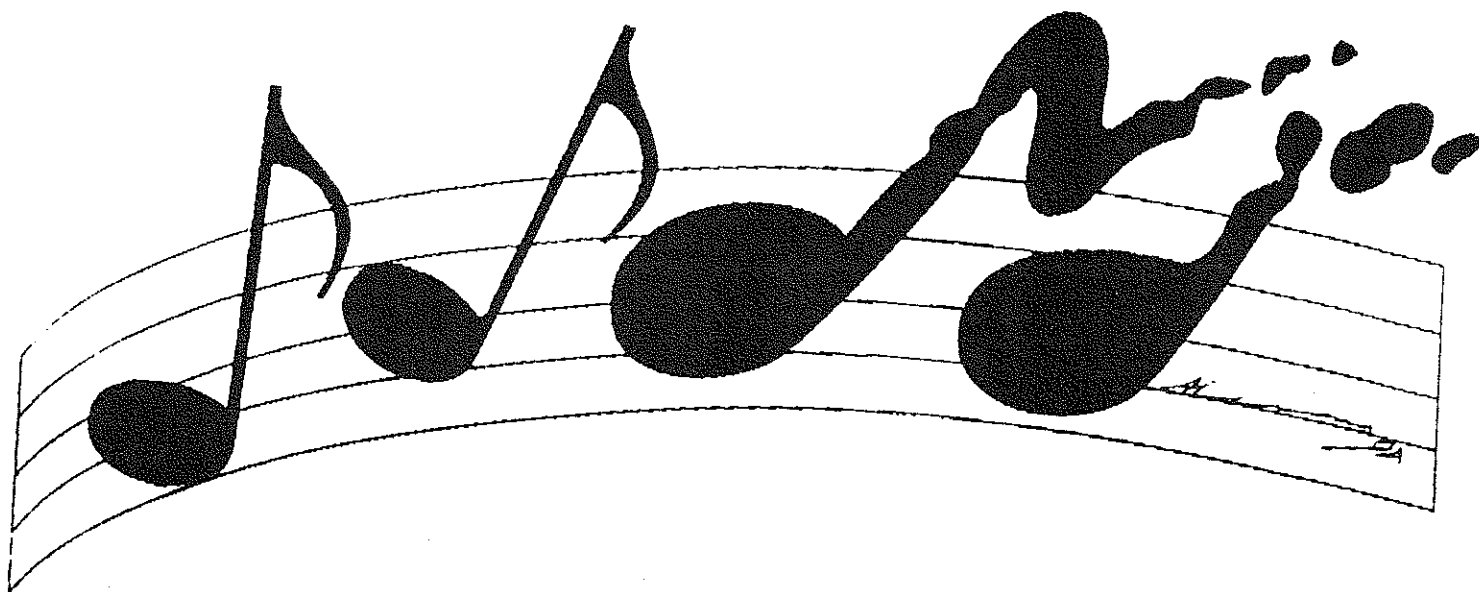

Mike Steinel

Mike Steinel is a jazz trumpeter, pianist, composer and arranger. He is presently Associate Professor of Jazz Studies at the University of North Texas where he teaches jazz improvisation and pedagogy of jazz improvisation. Prior to coming to UNT Mike taught at Northern Illinois University and was active as a performer and clinician in the Chicago area. Mike has served on the faculties of the Jamey Aebersold Improvisation Workshop, the Saskatchewan School of the Arts, the Musike Blekinge Storbansleger (Sweden), the Missouri Jazz Workshop, and others. He founded and directs the UNT Jazz Combo Workshop and UNT Jazz Trumpet Workshop. He has performed with numerous jazz artists such as Clark Terry, Don Ellis, Bill Evans, Jerry Bergonzi and has recorded with the Chicago Jazz Quintet and the Frank Mantooth Big Band. He is the composer of numerous jazz compositions and the author of a book on jazz improvisation, Building A Jazz Vocabulary. His new jazz method, Essential Elements for Jazz Ensemble is slated for publication next year. Mike holds degrees in music from Emporia State University (BME) and North Texas State University (MME). From 1979 to 1983 he served as Jazz Artist In Residence at Bethel College in Kansas. He has received honors including a jazz fellowship grant for the National Endowment for the Arts and a Chairman Grant from the State of Illinois. In 1994 he served as Co-chair of the Jazz Panel of the National Endowment for the Arts. Mike plays Yamaha trumpets and flugelhorns.

STEPHEN CRAWFORD

Stephen Crawford is in his fifth year as Director of Bands and Percussion Studies at Temple College. He holds degrees from Minot State University, University of Northern Iowa and the University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory of Music. He is currently the principal percussionist/timpanist with the Temple Symphony Orchestra, music director of the "Ritmo y Mas Percussion Group" and is the conductor of the TC Wind Symphony, Chamber Orchestra, and Percussion Ensemble.

Crawford is in constant demand as percussion performer, clinician and conductor having appeared throughout the United States, Canada, Mexico and Ireland. This summer he has been invited to conduct and lecture in Scotland. He is a member of CBDNA, PAS, NACWPI, TMEA, TBA, and the Conductors Guild.

ROBERT McELROY

Robert McElroy is the artistic director and conductor of the Houston Symphonic Band. He is also the recently retired Coordinator of Visual and Performing Arts for the Goose Creek CISD in Baytown, Texas. A 1969 graduate of Sam Houston State University, McElroy's teaching career began in Bellville, Texas and continued in the Cypress-Fairbanks district. McElroy received his Masters degree from the University of Houston in 1991 and he began his career in school administration at that time.

The Houston Symphonic Band was formed in 1985 just as McElroy was elected Band Chairman (and later President) of the Texas Music Educators Association (1986-90). McElroy has served on the Executive Board of the Texas Music Adjudicators Association and two four-year terms on the concert band music selection committee for UIL.

The HSB is one of the more accomplished community bands in the country having performed with many renowned composers/conductors. The band has received the praise of many noteworthy conductors including Dr. Francis McBeth, Geoffrey Brand and Col. John Bourgeois. The band will tour Europe during the summer of 2000 and return to perform with Larry Sutherland (Cal State, Fresno). On August 18, 2000, the band will host Harvey Phillips, Bob Daniel, Grady Hallman and other low brass virtuosi in a concert at the famed Stude Hall on the campus of Rice University in Houston, Texas

The band has several discs produced under the Mark Custom Recording label and several others under its own label through Glenn Wheeler Productions in Houston.

McElroy is adjunct professor of music at the Northwest College of the Houston Community College System, and performs consulting duties for various TEA Education Service Centers and school districts in Texas. He frequently has the opportunity to work with school bands, regional honor bands and has conducted the Springfield (MO) Community Band, the West Houston Concert Band, the Ft. Bend Symphony Orchestra and the Texas Private and Parochial School's All-State Band.

Robert, his wife Marie, and her son Steven have recently moved to their lovely retirement home in Bellville, Texas where Marie works out of the home as a successful flute instructor and Steven is an exceptional French horn player in the Bellville High School band.
