

#### Dr. Mike Steinel

Mike Steinel is a jazz trumpeter, pianist, composer, and arranger. He is presently Associate Professor of Jazz Studies at the University of North Texas where he teaches jazz improvisation and the pedagogy of jazz improvisation. Prior to joining the UNT faculty, Mike served on the jazz faculty at Northern Illinois University and was active as a performer, arranger, and clinician in the Chicago area.

Mike has served on the faculties of the Clark Terry Jazz Camp, the Jamey Aebersold Improvisation Workshop, the Saskatchewan Summer Jazz Camp, and the Missouri Jazz Residency. He serves as director of the UNT Jazz Combo Workshop. He has performed with numerous jazz artists such as Clark Terry, Don Ellis, Bill Evans, Jerry Bergonzi, and has recorded with the Chicago Jazz Quintet and the Frank Mantooth Big Band. He appears as soloist on two albums by the Frank Mantooth Big Band; **Persevere**, on the **Optimism** label, and **Dangerous Precedent** on **Seabreeze** Records.

Mike holds degrees in music from Emporia State (BME) and North Texas State University (MME). After leaving NTSU in 1979 he served as "Jazz Artist in Residence" for four years at Bethel College in North Newton, Kansas.

Mike has received numerous honors; including an Illinois Arts Council Chairman's Grant (1985), and a jazz fellowship grant from the National Endowment for the Arts (1987). He has performed as soloist at the MENC Convention, the NAJE National Convention, and the Mid-West Band and Orchestra Clinic. He is the author of a book on jazz improvisation, **Building a Jazz Vocabulary**. In 1993 he served on the Jazz Advisory Panel for the National Endowment for the Arts.

#### Dr. Kevin L. Sedatole

Kevin L. Sedatole joined the faculty of Stephen F. Austin State University in the fall of 1991 as Associate Director of Bands. His duties include directing the "Lumberjack" Marching Band and conducting the SFA Symphonic Band. Additionally, he teaches conducting and wind literature.

Before coming to SFASU, Dr. Sedatole taught in the Klein and Austin Independent School Districts, receiving top honors at UIL contests and state festivals. Dr. Sedatole was the honorable mention winner (the only award given) in the first Frederick Fennell International Young Conductors Competition held in December of 1992. He has studied conducting with Jerry Junkin, Larry Rachleff, H. Robert Reynolds, Eugene Corporon, Michael Haithcock, and Allan McMurray.

A native of Texas, Dr. Sedatole holds degrees from Baylor University and the University of Texas at Austin. He is a member of the College Band Directors National Association, Texas Band Masters Association and is affiliated with Kappa Kappa Psi and Tau Beta Sigma.
