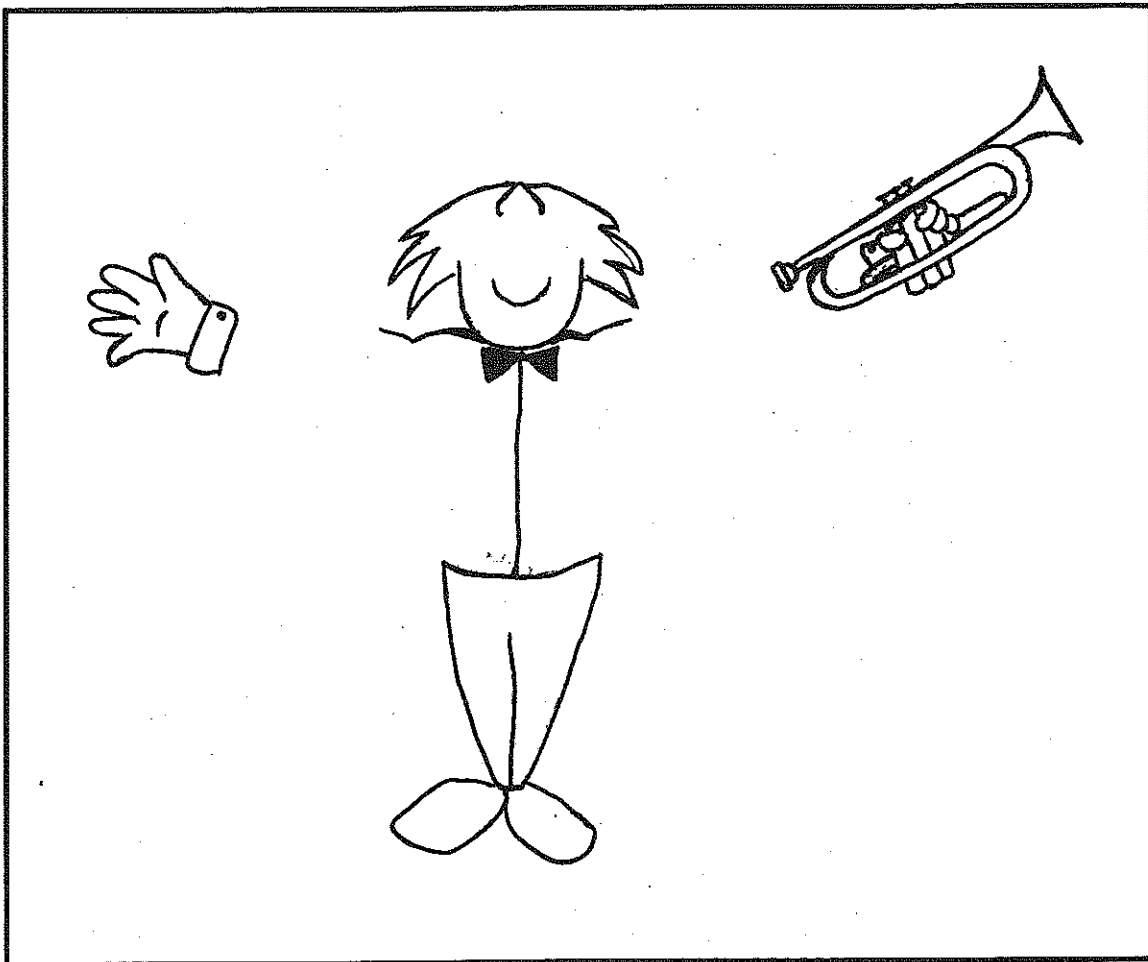

#### **Dr. Robert A. Winslow**

Dr. Robert A. Winslow, Director of Bands and Professor of Music in the College of Music at the University of North Texas, is a conductor of national and international reputation. He has conducted bands and orchestras and served as an adjudicator throughout the United States, Europe and Japan. Recently, he conducted the Wind Ensemble on a two week tour, concert/cultural exchange, of Japan at the invitation of the Japan Band Clinic and Yamaha Corporation.

Dr. Winslow was appointed to the faculty of the College of Music as Director of Bands in 1975. Previously he held similar positions at the UCLA and at Boston University. His experiences also include eight years of high school and junior college teaching in Los Angeles and Santa Monica, California.

Dr. Winslow is a Regents Professor of Music at the University of North Texas, a recognition given to faculty who have exhibited outstanding leadership and accomplishment. He is a member of the prestigious American Bandmaster Assn. He has recorded and performed as a Percussionist with Zubin Mehta, Georg Solti, Eugene Ormandy, Seiji Ozawa, Andre Previn, Igor Stravinsky, Carlos Chavez, William Kraft, Lucas Foss, Roger Wagner, John Cage, and Elliott Carter, Ernst Toch and Ingolf Dahl. For many years he was a regular member of the Los Angeles Philharmonic Orchestra and the Hollywood Bowl Symphony Orchestra. He was an original member of the Los Angeles Percussion Ensemble under the direction of William Kraft and has been a freelance performer for television, motion pictures, recording and musical theater in Los Angeles and Boston.

#### **Noe J. Marmolejo**

Noe J. Marmolejo is a Professor of Music at the University of Houston School of Music. He is the Director of Jazz Ensembles, Trumpet Ensemble, and Brass Coach for the wind ensemble. He received his Bachelor of Music Education degree from Southern Methodist, a performers certificate from the College Conservatory of Music at the University of Cincinnati and a Master of Music in Conducting from the University of Houston.

Before joining the University of Houston faculty, he directed the award-winning Westchester High School (Spring Branch) Orchestra and Jazz Ensemble for seven years. Active as a teacher, adjudicator, lecturer, and clinician; Mr. Marmolejo has also performed with Bob Hope, Vicki Carr, Lainie Kazan, Joan Rivers, and his groups have concertized with such luminaries as Lew Solofr, Marvin Stamm, Carl Fontanna, Conrad Herwig, Jimmy Ford, Tony Campise, Joe Henderson, Terence Blanchard, and Dennis Dotson. He is also the Secretary of the International Association of Jazz Educator's Texas Chapter and is editor of the award-winning IAJE Texas Unit Newsletter.
