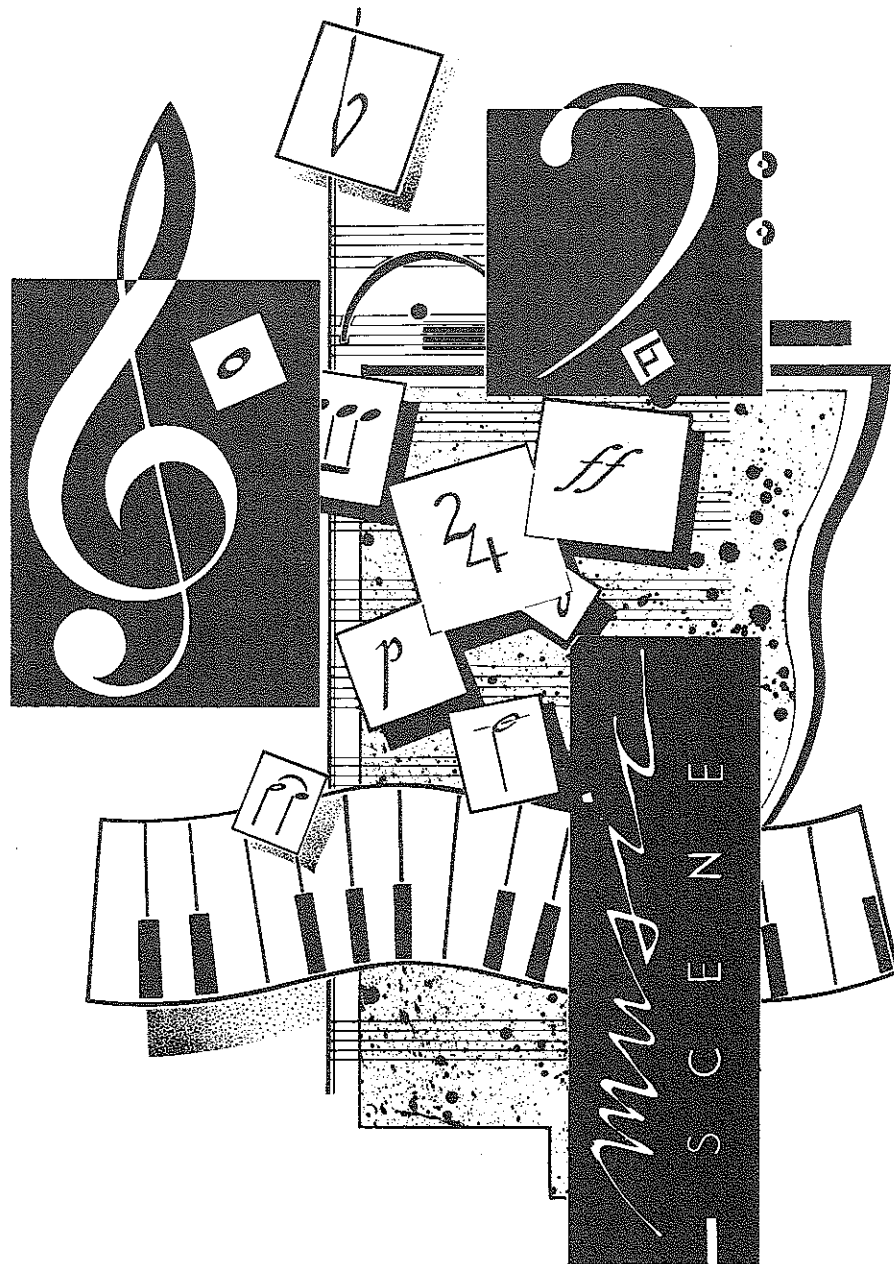

Dr. Gary Sousa

Gary Sousa is in his fourth year as Director of Bands at Sam Houston State University in Huntsville, Texas. As Director of Bands, Professor Sousa conducts the Wind Ensemble, teaches courses in conducting and repertoire, directs the Masters program in Wind Conducting, and oversees the entire band program. Prior to accepting this appointment, Dr. Sousa was Associate Director of Bands at Baylor University where he conducted the Symphonic Band, co-directed the Marching Band, and taught courses in conducting and music education.

Dr. Sousa began his teaching career in 1976 in Weston, Connecticut where he taught at both the junior and senior high school levels. Professor Sousa received his Bachelor of Music Education from the University of Rhode Island. He received both his master's and doctorate from The Ohio State University in Columbus, Ohio under the tutelage of Craig Kirchoff.

Dr. Sousa maintains an active schedule as guest conductor and clinician throughout Texas and the United States. He holds memberships in many organizations including Pi Kappa Lambda, Music Educators National Conference, College Band Directors National Association, National Band Association, World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles, and the Texas Music Educators Association.

Rod Cannon

Director of Jazz Studies and Percussion at Sam Houston State University in Huntsville, Texas, Mr. Cannon, Associate Professor of Music, earned his bachelor's and master's at SHSU. Mr. Cannon has considerable skill as a percussionist and is an active performer on recitals, chamber music concerts and as a commercial musician including many regular performances with leading jazz artists in the greater Houston area. Mr. Cannon has brought much excitement and enthusiasm to the study of jazz.

Prior to coming to Sam Houston State, Mr. Cannon was a very successful teacher at Brazoswood High School of Brazosport I.S.D. Under his leadership, the band program at Brazoswood High School became known for excellence in all areas. Currently Mr. Cannon is pursuing doctoral studies at the University of North Texas.

As Director of Jazz Studies at Sam Houston, Mr. Cannon rehearses two jazz ensembles each week and teaches jazz improvisation, in addition to his duties as percussion instructor.
