John C. Stansberry

John Stansberry was appointed Director of Bands at Southwest Texas State University in the fall of 1981. His responsibilities at SWTSU include conducting the Wind Ensemble as well as teaching graduate and undergraduate music education courses. Mr. Stansberry received his Bachelor of Music Education degree from Drake University and a Master of Music degree, oboe performance, from Michigan State University. From 1976 to 1981, he was the Assistant Director of Bands at The University of North Texas. Mr. Stansberry has had articles and reviews published in professional music periodicals in the United States and Australia. His public school experience has included teaching in Michigan and New South Wales, Australia. Mr. Stansberry frequently serves as adjudicator and clinician throughout the State of Texas and the nation.

James Riggs

James Riggs holds a BME from the University of Toledo and an MM from the University of North Texas. Mr. Riggs teaches saxophone, directs the Two O'Clock Lab Band and teaches jazz styles analysis. He has served on the faculty at the University of Toledo (Ohio) and has performed with the Fort Worth Symphony, the Dallas Symphony Orchestra, Nelson Riddle, Doc Severinson, Henry Mancini, Stan Kenton and others.

As a saxophonist and clinician Riggs has appeared for the Texas Music Educators; Ohio Music Educators; the National Association of Jazz Educators; the North American Saxophone Alliance; the Universities of Kansas, Northern Illinois and California; and a jazz camp in Stockholm, Sweden. He has conducted many all-state, regional and festival jazz ensembles throughout the United States. A winner of the Yamaha Scholarship Soloist Competition, Riggs can be heard in performances of Gershwin's "Porgy and Bess", "An American In Paris" and Prokoviev's "Lieutenant Kije" with the Dallas Symphony Orchestra on RCA records.
