Dr. Barry W. Johnson

Barry W. Johnson is in his eighth year as Director of Bands at Lamar University in Beaumont, Texas. Dr. Johnson holds a Bachelor of Music Education and a Master of Arts from Sam Houston State University in Huntsville, Texas. In 1986 he received the Doctor of Education degree from the University of Houston.

Dr. Johnson's teaching positions have included Asst. Professor of Music, Texarkana, College; Asst. Director of Bands, Highland Park H.S.; Band Director, Hillsboro H.S.; Band Director, Woodville H.S.; and Associate Director of Bands, Lamar University. In 1985 he was promoted to his present position, Director of Bands at Lamar University.

During Dr. Johnson's career as a high school band director, his bands received ten consecutive U.I.L. Sweepstakes awards from 1974-1983. His 1980 Woodville band was named Texas Music Educators Association Class AAA Honor Band and performed for the TMEA convention in 1981. The Lamar University Symphonic Band under Dr. Johnson's direction has performed for the TMEA convention (1987) and for the College Band Directors National Association, Norman, Oklahoma (1990).

Dr. Johnson is an active clinician, guest conductor, and adjudicator. His memberships include the College Band Directors National Association, National Band Association, Texas Music Educators Association, and the Texas Bandmasters Association among others. In 1981 Johnson received the "Citation of Excellence" award from the National Band Association and the "Leadership Award" from TMEA. In 1986 he received a certificate of recognition from Sam Houston State University as one of five of their most outstanding graduates in the field of music.

Dr. J. Wayne Dyess

J. Wayne Dyess is a graduate of Stephen F. Austin State University (1970). Upon graduation, Dyess auditioned for and was accepted into the United States Navy Band in Washington, D.C. where he performed as soloist and trombone section leader from 1971-1975. During his military career, he earned the Master of Music degree from the Catholic University in Washington, D.C. (1975). In May 1988, Dyess received the Doctor of Education degree from the University of Houston.

Dyess taught two years at Central Junior High in Nederland where his band won the Sweepstakes Award as well as many other trophies and honors. The Nederland High School Jazz Band, directed by Dyess, was selected by the National Association of Jazz Educators as one of eight outstanding jazz ensembles from across the nation, and this band appeared on an album (NAJE Projects II) in 1977.

Dr. Dyess is currently the Associate Director of Bands and the Director of Jazz Studies at Lamar University. His duties include directing the Jazz Ensembles, Pop Band, Concert Band, teaching private applied trombone and several music education methods and graduate courses. Additionally, Dyess is an active clinician/soloist throughout Texas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and Arkansas.
