Dr. Gary Garner

Gary Garner is currently in his 24th year on the faculty at West Texas State University, where he holds the position of Professor of Music and Director of Bands and Orchestra. He began his teaching career in Lubbock at Hutchinson Jr. High School and later at Monterey High School, and then the University of Southern California as director of the Trojan Marching Band prior to accepting his appointment at WTSU.

The WTSU Symphonic Band, under Garner's direction, has come to be recognized as one of the top such collegiate ensembles in the country. The band appeared at Carnegie Hall in 1983 and will return this spring.

Garner has traveled throughout the country as clinician, guest conductor, and as flute soloist. He has recently completed two albums of flute trios: The First Family of Flute with sons Brad and Blair and Flutes A Tre with son Brad and the eminent American flutist, Julius Baker.

Sam Trimble

Sam Trimble has performed with Stan Kenton and other Big Bands, along with playing lead trumpet for such entertainers as Tony Bennett, Jack Jones, Bob Hope and others. He has made guest appearances, both as a trumpet soloist and as a conductor, with many public school, college, and professional bands and orchestras across the country, including the El Paso Symphony Orchestra where he is presently Principal Trumpet.

Currently he is coordinator of the Lab Band and Trumpet areas at the University of Texas at El Paso.

Trimble has developed Jazz Programs to such a quality that the groups were featured with such entertainers as Bob Hope, Vicky Carr, Red Skelton, Gladys Knight, Clark Terry, Dizzy Gillespie, Kai Winding, Linda Carter, Ed Shaughnessey, Tony Campise, and many others.

Under his direction, groups have received national recognition (an invitation and performance at the National Association of Jazz Educators National Convention), and international recognition (invitations and performances at the prestigious Montreux Jazz Festival in Switzerland).
