Michael L. Haithcock

Michael Haithcock, a native of Kannoplis, North Carolina, holds degrees in music education from East Carolina University and Baylor University. As Director of Bands at Baylor, he conducts the nationally prominent Baylor Wind Ensemble and is responsible for the administration of Baylor's diverse collegiate band program. He has received acclaim as an innovative teacher and conductor through appearances across the country, most recently in a series of week-long residencies at the North Carolina School of the Arts. His performances have been applauded by composers such as Samual Adler, Karel Husa, Sherwood Shaffer, and Richard Willis. Mr. Haithcock has published a variety of articles on conducting and wind ensemble literature in addition to his recorded performances on the Crest, Crystal, and Mark labels.

G. Darrell Holt

Darrell Holt is Director of Jazz Studies at Stephen F. Austin State University in Nacogdoches, Texas, a position he has held since 1969, where his "Swinging Axes" have participated several times in The National Jazz Festival. He holds degrees in music education from Stephen F. Austin and the University of North Texas. He is active as an adjucator and as a clinician at numerous festivals and is much in demand as a studio writer. He has produced over 30 albums as well as numerous jingles. He has also arranged and composed for many high schools and universities throughout the country.

In 1985, Holt was commissioned to write eight arrangements and one original composition for trombonist Carl Fontana and the San Antonio Symphony and has received a National Endowment of the Arts grant to write a composition for jazz band and jazz choir.
