Glenn Richter

Glenn Richter is in his sixth year as Director of Longhorn Bands for the University of Texas. In addition to his responsibilities with the "Showband of the Southwest," Mr. Richter conducts the Wind Ensemble and teaches conducting.

A native of New Braunfels, Mr. Richter has served as the Director of Bands at the College-Conservatory of Music, University of Cincinnati, the Marching Band Conductor at the University of Michigan, as well as conducting positions at Reagan and LBJ High Schools in Austin. He is active as a guest conductor, clinician and adjudicator throughout the United States and Europe.

Kent Kidwell

Kent Kidwell is Professor of Music and Director of Bands & Jazz Studies at Central State University in Edmond, Oklahoma. His award winning jazz ensembles have achieved a record of excellence in performance throughout the nation. The C.S.U. Dixieland Band, "The Civilized Tribe," has the distinction of being the only group in America to have won the National Championship twice in the NAJE/Southern Comfort National Collegiate Dixieland Band Competition (1983-1986).

Dr. Kidwell taught in the public schools of Oklahoma for five years before going to Central State. He played 2nd Trombone for three years in the Baltimore Symphony and was Principal Trombonist in the Okohoma City Symphony for eight years.

He lives in Edmond where he and his wife, Jane, have three children: Jeff, 22; John, 18; and Mary, 16.
