**Conductor - Clinician**

Dr. Gary Garner is Director of Bands at West Texas State University in Canyon, Texas. He is a graduate of Amarillo High School and he received his B.S. in music education from Texas Tech and M.M. from the University of Southern California and also his D.M.A. from the University of Southern California. Dr. Garner's experience includes: band director at Hutchinson Jr. High School and Monterey High School in Lubbock, Texas 1954-59; director of the University of Southern California Trojan Marching Band 1959-63; and presently Professor of Music and Director of Bands at W.T.S.U. Dr. Garner has served as guest flute soloist, guest conductor and clinician throughout western and southwestern states. He is in constant demand as a soloist, clinician, and judge throughout the southwest.

Dr. Garner is a member of the following organizations: Texas Music Educators Association, Pi Kappa Lambda (national music scholastic fraternity), Phi Beta Mu (national honorary band director's fraternity), Kappa Kappa Psi (national band fraternity), Phi Mu Alpha (national music fraternity).

**Guest Soloist**

Dr. Neill Humfeld is Professor of Music and Chairman of the Instrumental Music Division at East Texas State University in Commerce, Texas. He is a native of Kansas with B.M.E. and M.M.E from the University of Kansas, M.M. (trombone) from Eastman School of Music and D.M.A. also from Eastman.

Dr. Humfeld taught music in the public schools of Kansas, spent four years in the Air Force Bands as trombone soloist and conductor and then joined the E.T.S.U. faculty in 1958 where he was director of bands for ten years, and director of the Symphony Orchestra three years.

The E.T.S.U. Trombone Choir was organized and developed by Dr. Humfeld. This is a select group of 18 to 24 trombonists which is nationally known for its performances at the First National Trombone Workshop, as well as numerous other state and regional conventions, and appearances on television and radio.

Dr. Humfeld is a trombone clinician, soloist, and also technical advisor for the C.G. Conn Corp. He is the author of several articles on the trombone and the trombone choir.

In 1972 he received the "Outstanding Distinguished Teacher Award" from the E.T.S.U. faculty, and 1974 was selected for the "Outstanding Educators of America Award". He is a member of the National Association of College Wind and Percussion Instructors, International Trombone Assn., Texas Music Educators Assn., Texas Association of College Teachers, and Texas Band Masters Assn.
