Dr. Gary Wurtz

Gary Wurtz became the Director of the SFA School of Music in the fall of 2016, after having been the trumpet professor and director of the Swingin' Axes for twenty-four years. His other duties at SFA have included serving as the Associate Director for Undergraduate Studies, directing the Trumpet Ensemble, performing in the Pineywoods Brass Quintet and serving as Director of the esteemed SFA Summer Band Camps. His many students have gone on to positions as band directors, military bandmen, professional and amateur performers, college professors, church music ministers, businessmen, lawyers, and many other worthy professions. He has served the university as chair of the Faculty Senate as well as a member of numerous other committees, including the Strategic Planning Committee, Academic Admissions Standards Committee, University Scholarships Committee, Salary Equity Committee, and many others. In 2012 Dr. Wurtz was the recipient of the Teaching Excellence Award for the College of Fine Arts at SFA, and he was a finalist for the SFA Foundation's Excellence in Teaching Award in 2014.

Wurtz came to SFA from the Dallas area where he spent several years as a free-lance trumpeter and private instructor. He held the principal trumpet chair in the Richardson Symphony Orchestra from 1986 to 2001, taking a year off in 1989-1990 to play co-principal chair in La Orquesta Filarmónica de la UNAM in Mexico City and as principal trumpet in the National Orchestra of the Dominican Republic in Santo Domingo. At home in Nacogdoches, he has performed as principal trumpet in the Orchestra of the Pines, with whom he has been featured on the Brandenburg Concerto No. 2 by J.S. Bach (twice), Aaron Copland's Quiet City, Concerto in Re by Johann Friedrich Fasch and Concerto for Trumpet by Alexander Arutunian.

Wurtz has worked extensively as an orchestral musician, jazz musician, soloist and studio musician. He appears frequently as a soloist and clinician, both in the classical and jazz fields, at colleges, high schools and with professional organizations. A native of Alamogordo, New Mexico, Wurtz holds a Bachelor of Music Education from West Texas A&M University (1985), Master of Music Education from the University of North Texas (1987) and the Doctor of Musical Arts in Trumpet Performance from the University of North Texas (2001). His primary teachers have included Dr. Leonard Candelaria, Bert Truax, David Ritter and Art Holt. Wurtz has been married to his wife, Mindy, since 1987. They have two beautiful children, a son, Gage, and a daughter, Hannah. Gary is or has been affiliated with the International Trumpet Guild, Texas Music Educators Association, Texas Jazz Educators Association, American Federation of Musicians, Pi Kappa Lambda, Kappa Kappa Psi, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. He is available as a clinician, adjudicator and performer, and is an artist clinician for Schilke Trumpets.

Mr. Fred Allen

Fred J. Allen is Director of Bands at Stephen F. Austin State University in Nacogdoches, Texas. In addition to conducting the Wind Ensemble at SFASU, he also teaches conducting and music education classes. He oversees nearly three hundred band students involved in the SFA band program, in three concert groups, the marching and pep bands and several chamber ensembles.

Under his direction, the Wind Ensemble at SFA has performed at conventions of the Texas Music Educators Association and College Band Directors National Association. His SFA Wind Ensemble has performed with several guest artists: trumpeter Allen Vizzutti, the Resounding Winds Saxophone Quartet, clarinetist Eddie Daniels, and conductors Keith Brion, Frederick Fennell and Sarah McKoin. Under his leadership the SFA Wind Ensemble continues its long tradition of commissioning new works from composers. Recent commissions have produced works from David Maslanka, Adam Gorb, James Syler and Frank Ticheli.

Allen has conducted All-Region and All-State Bands throughout Texas and the Southwest, where he is also an active concert clinician and adjudicator. He has often served as guest conductor for bands playing at the Mid-West Band Convention and the Texas Music Educators Association Convention, and has also conducted the Seoul Wind Ensemble and the AI Fine Concert Band in Taegu, Korea. He remains current in the public school classroom through regular visits to area band classes, from beginners through high school.

Allen has published several pieces for band which draw upon his experience teaching band in the public schools in Texas. These works have been performed frequently at band conventions and festivals across the United States and recently, in Korea, Great Britain, Germany and Australia. He has several commissioned works in progress.

As a woodwind specialist, he has performed professionally at Opryland U.S.A., for the Ice Capades and for over forty musical productions and operas. He is a former member of the Orchestra of the Pines, the Abilene Philharmonic, the Fort Worth Civic Orchestra, and the Irving Symphony, as well as community bands in Fort Worth and Lubbock.
