Key to Walks Grading System

Distance

S = short - under 5km M = medium - 5-10kmL = long - over 10km

Terrain1-3 = Graded or open terrain, no scrub

4-7 = Bush, minor scrub, rainforest 8-10 = Rocks, creeks, rockhopping, scrambling, thick scrub, major rock scrambling using hands, technical

Difficulty

1-3 = Easy, suitable for beginners
4-7 = Medium, reasonable fitness required
8-10 = Hard, strenuous, fit walkers only
