

September 28 & 29, 2019 Food Vendor Application

Traditional foods are a huge part of the Dancing Goats experience. Our food vendors bring treats much like those that sustained and delighted the people who built our community. As we showcase the first-born art of Appalachia, storytelling, and acoustic mountain music, we want to enjoy some down-home vittles. We hope you'll join us for two days of breathing that wild mountain air, seeing old friends, making new friends, and introducing your culinary skills to a whole new market.

Food booth spaces must be covered. Individual spaces are 10' deep and up to12' wide. The cost is just \$100 for two days; \$200 for a food truck which may have additional space. You can send a \$50 deposit if your application is received by Aug. 9. The remainder will be due Sept. 20. Deposits will be returned (minus \$5) to anyone who is not accepted. To avoid too much duplication and provide traditional foods, we need your application as soon as possible and we may ask if you can eliminate some items from your offering. Include with your application a photo of your booth or truck or direct us to your website. Digital photos are acceptable with emailed applications. High resolution photos may be used in festival publicity.

Food vendors must have a trash can for customers. Seating is appreciated. Vendors providing at least one table and six chairs will receive a 5% fee refund. Signs and displays must be within the paid space, and sales cannot be made away from your booth. We'll provide the music so don't bring your radios, CDs, etc. No animals are allowed in food booths with the exception of certified service dogs. Vendors cannot smoke on the festival site or pass out political handbills. No individual raffles. Each vendor is responsible for sales tax collection and reporting.

You must provide a certificate of insurance listing Dancing Goats FolkFest as an additional insured.

Security will be provided Friday and Saturday nights, but equipment, signs, etc. must not be left outside your tent. Dancing Goats is not liable for anything broken or stolen (see agreement below). All vehicles must be parked in designated vendor parking, which is on site.
