

APPEAL PROCESS

Who can appeal?

- The Respondent may appeal only if the suspension exceeds 30 days or 15 games.
- The Complainant may appeal only if the decision found “no violation occurred.”
- Either party may appeal if a cost award was issued.

What cannot be appealed?

- Suspensions below the 30-day/15-game threshold.
- Procedural decisions and orders issued throughout the complaint process.

Where do I file an appeal?

- All appeals can be filed directly with the Sport Dispute Resolution Centre of Canada (SDRCC). Appeals are handled independently by the SDRCC.

When do I file my appeal?

- The Policy requires appeals to be submitted within 14 calendar days of receipt of the decision.
