



FROM THE DESK OF OUR SEMINARIAN

Last Thursday, we celebrated the feast of one of my favorite saints and biggest role models, St. Mary Magdalene. She was one of the Lord's closest and most loyal followers while He walked this earth, and for this reason she is among the most beloved saints of our Church. She was the sister of Martha and Lazarus, two of Our Lord's devoted followers and generous sponsors, and her relation to them tells us that she too was wealthy and lived comfortably, but unlike her siblings she used her wealth for vanity and sin. She was a worldly woman, but that began to change when she first encountered the Lord Jesus Christ. In time, Mary Magdalene underwent an incredible transformation, a radical conversion! Torrential weeping, an exorcism from seven demons, the beginning of a new life of charity, and a commitment to a lifetime of penance all describe this fantastic change in the heart of Mary Magdalene, and all beginning with a single gaze from the Lord to one of his beloved prodigal daughters! "What was Mary's first act as a new woman?" You may ask. She took her precious jar of spikenard and resolved to offer it to the one who healed her. Spikenard was a precious and expensive perfumed oil commonly associated with marriage in ancient times, and up to this point Mary would have used this as perfume at the many lavish parties she hosted at her estate in Magdalum. We may call this jar of oil a symbol of her old life. Now, she is ready to lay it all down at her Savior's feet. Imagine this woman barging into the house where Jesus was staying for a meal, her face soaked in tears, hair disheveled, and wearing dirty garments in place of the fancy clothes she used to wear, coming up behind Jesus and pouring out the entire jar of precious nard over His head, weeping at His feet, and drying them with her hair. Imagine her then taking the empty alabaster jar and smashing it to pieces on the stone floor, as a sign to herself and to all around her that she will never go back to the way things were! Jesus gave her a new life and new freedom, and here she is offering her whole self at His feet. In return for this act of love, Jesus forgives her of all her sins and welcomes her into the company of His followers. GOSPEL - JOHN 6, 1-15

Jesus went across the Sea of Galilee. A large crowd followed him, because they saw the signs he was performing on the sick. Jesus went up on the mountain, and there he sat down with his disciples. The Jewish feast of Passover was near. When Jesus raised his eyes and saw that a large crowd was coming to him, he said to Philip, "Where can we buy enough food for them to eat?" He said this to test him, because he himself knew what he was going to do. Philip answered him, "Two hundred days' wages worth of food would not be enough for each of them to have a little." One of his disciples, Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, said to him, "There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what good are these for so many?" Jesus said, "Have the people recline." Now there was a great deal of grass in that place. So the men reclined, about five thousand in number. Then Jesus took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed them to those who were reclining, and also as much of the fish as they wanted. When they had had their fill, he said to his disciples, "Gather the fragments left over, so that nothing will be wasted." So they collected them, and filled twelve wicker baskets with fragments from the five barley loaves that had been more than they could eat. When the people saw the sign he had done, they said, "This is truly the Prophet, the one who is to come into the world." Since Jesus knew that they were going to come and carry him off to make him king, he withdrew again to the mountain alone.

EVANGELIO - JUAN 6, 1-15

En aquel tiempo, Jesús se fue a la otra orilla del mar de Galilea o lago de Tiberíades. Lo seguía mucha gente, porque habían visto los signos que hacía curando a los enfermos. Jesús subió al monte y se sentó allí con sus discípulos.

Estaba cerca la Pascua, festividad de los judíos. Viendo Jesús que mucha gente lo seguía, le dijo a Felipe: "¿Cómo compraremos pan para que coman éstos?" Le hizo esta pregunta para ponerlo a prueba, pues él bien sabía lo que iba a hacer. Felipe le respondió: "Ni doscientos denarios de pan bastarían para que a cada uno le tocara un pedazo de pan". Otro de sus discípulos, Andrés, el hermano de Simón Pedro, le dijo: "Aquí hay un muchacho que trae cinco panes de cebada y dos pescados. Pero, ¿qué es eso para tanta gente?" Jesús le respondió: "Díganle a la gente que se siente". En aquel lugar había mucha hierba. Todos, pues, se sentaron ahí; y tan sólo los hombres eran unos cinco mil.

Enseguida tomó Jesús los panes, y después de dar gracias a Dios, se los fue repartiendo a los que se habían sentado a comer. Igualmente les fue dando de los pescados todo lo que quisieron. Despues de que todos se saciaron, dijo a sus discípulos: "Recojan los pedazos sobrantes, para que no se desperdicien". Los recogieron y con los pedazos que sobraron de los cinco panes llenaron doce canastos.

Entonces la gente, al ver el signo que Jesús había hecho, decía: "Éste es, en verdad, el profeta que habría de venir al mundo". Pero Jesús, sabiendo que iban a llevárselo para proclamarlo rey, se retiró de nuevo a la montaña, él solo.



MIXED MOTIVES

Once there was a mystic who would sit at the edge of a small village and stir dirt and water into mud for a few hours. Then she would reach into the pot and pull out a gold nugget. One onlooker decided he wanted to learn how to make gold too, so he went to her for instructions. The mystic, insisting that the task was rather simple, showed him how she did it. Soon the student acquired a pot of his own. After all, why not! Wealth should be shared. He placed dirt and water in it and began to stir. After several hours, however, his repeated glances into the pot had turned up not even the smallest nugget. On and on he went, day and night. Next morning - still no success!

The young man returned to the mystic and explained what had happened. The mystic thought for a moment and then said, "I failed to mention one important thing. You must never think about gold while you are stirring, or it will not work." Most of us live our lives with our eyes fixed on a future event. The student studies so that he'll get a job. The jogger exercises so as to enjoy good health. People save for automobiles, homes, vacations. All this is good.

Sometimes, unfortunately, we can treat God like that! We see God as a means to something else. We approach prayer with the same competitive attitude as we do other areas.
