

FROM THE DESK OF OUR SEMINARIAN

This Sunday's readings are all about shepherds. The Church presents sections of the Bible that remind us that Our Lord is the Good Shepherd who leads us, his flock, to the fulness of life.

We begin with bad shepherds. In our first reading the Lord speaks through the prophet Jeremiah to say, "Woe to the shepherds who mislead and scatter the flock of my pasture" (Jer 23:1). There were many priests and prophets at the time of Jeremiah, but unfortunately many of them did not live as true men of God. Too many of them wanted an easy life and simply told people the things they wanted to hear. The results were disastrous. Without sound instruction, people abandoned the right ways of the Lord and his commands, and eventually the whole nation to which Jeremiah prophesied was conquered by its enemies and taken away into exile.

The Lord loves his people, and so he speaks out against these bad shepherds by saying, "You have scattered my sheep and driven them away. You have not cared for them, but I will take care to punish your evil deeds" (Jer. 23:2). The Lord goes on to promise to fulfill the role of shepherd himself. "I myself will gather the remnant of my flock from all the lands to which I have driven them and bring them back to the their meadow; there they shall increase and multiply" (Jer. 23:3).

Today's Gospel shows us the Lord fulfilling his promise. Jesus Christ looks upon his people and is moved with genuine compassion (Mark 6:34). They appear to him to be "sheep without a shepherd", and so he responds as a good shepherd would: "he began to teach them many things" (Mark 6:34).

But more than teach, Jesus goes on to lay down his life for us in order to reconcile us with God. St. Paul reminds us of this truth in the second reading today. "In Christ Jesus you who once were far off have become near by the blood of Christ. For he is our peace, he who made both one and broke down the dividing wall of enmity, through his flesh..." (Eph 2:13-15).

Christ died so that we, his sheep, might again live in God's grace and in the hope of eternal life. Jesus is truly the Good Shepherd, and we praise God for giving us so great a pastor. With the Psalmist we pray, "The Lord is my shepherd, there is nothing I shall want" (Ps 23:1).

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DE NUESTRO SEMINARISTA

Las lecturas de este domingo tienen que ver con los pastores. La Iglesia presenta secciones de la Biblia que nos recuerdan que Nuestro Señor es el Buen Pastor que nos conduce a nosotros, su rebaño, de la vida. Comenzamos con los malos pastores. En nuestra primera lectura, el Señor dice: "¡Ay de los pastores que extravían y dispersan el rebaño de mi prado!" (Jer. 23:1). Había muchos sacerdotes y profetas en la época de Jeremías, pero desafortunadamente mucho de ellos no vivieron como verdaderos hombres de Dios. Mucho de ellos querían una vida fácil y simplemente le decían a la gente las cosas que querían escuchar. Los resultados fueron desastrosos. Sin una instrucción sólida, la gente abandonó los caminos correctos del Señor y sus mandamientos, y finalmente toda la nación a la que profetizó Jeremías fue conquistada por sus enemigos y llevada al exilio.

El Señor ama a su gente, y por eso habla en contra de estos malos pastores diciendo: "Dispersaste mis ovejas y las ahuyentaste. No las cuidaste, pero yo me encargaré de castigar tus malas acciones" (Jer 23:3). El Señor continúa prometiendo cumplir el papel de pastor mismo. "Yo mismo recogeré el resto de mi rebaño de todas las tierras a las que los he arrojado y los llevaré de regreso a su prado; allí crecerán y se multiplicarán" (Jer. 23:2).

El evangelio de hoy nos muestra al Señor cumpliendo su promesa. Jesucristo mira a su gente y se siente movido por una compasión genuina. Le parecen "ovejas sin pastor", por lo que responde como lo haría un buen pastor: "comenzó a enseñarles muchas cosas" (Marcos 6:34). Pero más allá de la enseñanza, Jesús pasa a dar su vida por nosotros para reconciliarnos con Dios. San Pablo nos recuerda esta verdad en la segunda lectura de hoy. "En Cristo Jesús, ustedes que antes estaban lejos, se han acercado por la sangre de Cristo. Porque él es nuestra paz, el que hizo a los dos y derribó el muro divisorio de enemistad por su carne..." (Efesios 2:13-15). Cristo murió para que nosotros, sus ovejas, volvamos a vivir en la gracia de Dios y en la esperanza de la vida eterna. Jesús es verdaderamente el Buen Pastor, y alabamos a Dios por darnos un pastor tan grandioso. Con el salmista rezamos: "El Señor es mi pastor, nada me faltará (Sal 23,1).

GOSPEL - MC 6, 30-34

The apostles gathered together with Jesus and reported all they had done and taught. He said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." People were coming and going in great numbers, and they had no opportunity even to eat. So they went off in the boat by themselves to a deserted place. People saw them leaving and many came to know about it. They hastened there on foot from all the towns and arrived at the place before them. When he disembarked and saw the vast crowd, his heart was moved with pity for them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things.

EVANGELIO - MC 6, 30-34

Cuando Jesús desembarcó, vio una numerosa multitud que lo estaba esperando y se compadeció de ellos, porque andaban como ovejas sin pastor, y se puso a enseñarles muchas cosas.

WINDOWS OF WONDER

They never failed to fascinate him, those golden windows in the house on the other side of the valley. Regularly after supper, the boy would gaze across full of wonder and excitement. Who lived there? How happy those people must be in the midst of such beauty!

One evening as the sun set, he felt compelled to go there. It would be a long and difficult journey down into the dark valley with all its dangerous and wild creatures, and then the treacherous climb up the rocky hill-face to the house with the windows of wonder. But he set out, trusting his instincts to guide him through the night. He was able to accept the darkness because of the hope of what tomorrow would bring. At dawn, bruised and scratched, he began his ascension to heaven on earth.

Finally, breathless and weary, he knocked at the door. "Please tell me" he said to the lady who answered "is this the house with the golden windows?" Her eyes were full of compassion. Her voice full of concern. Would he understand? She pointed back over the valley, and there, high on the hill was his own little house, its windows on fire with the pure light of the morning sun. "There," said the woman gently "there where you live, you will find the windows of wonder." "The windows of wonder are for looking in at the rich mystery of our own being and spirit. 2021 QUO VADIS DAY CAMP

Quo Vadis is Latin for "Where are you going?" Legend tells us that St. Peter asked Jesus this question on the outskirts of Rome. And we know where Jesus went in response to His Father's will. Quo Vadis is a camp for Catholic high school boys (from those entering ninth grade to those having just completed their senior grade year) to deepen their faith, learn more about vocations, and better discern God's call in their lives. It is a time of recreation, fellowship, and prayer. Priests and seminarians from around the Diocese of Providence will be present to lead conversations and offer witness talks. Activities will include prayer, daily Mass, recreation (games/sports), group discussions, witness talks, a challenge course, and more...

LOCATION

The Quo Vadis camp will take place at the Seminary of Our Lady of Providence in Providence (485 Mount Pleasant Avenue). The seminary is where young men study for the priesthood. While the seminarians normally live at the seminary during the academic year, they return home to their families during the summer months. We will have access of the seminary's facilities and dorm rooms (beds, bedding and pillows provided), as well as the beautiful seminary grounds where outdoor activities will take place. DATE & TIME

Quo Vadis will take place Sunday July 25 - Wednesday July 28. Check-in for the camp is at the Seminary of Our Lady of Providence from 2-3pm on Sunday, July 25. Check-out is 1:30pm on Wednesday, July 28. If a participant will miss a day or a portion of a day of the retreat, he is welcome to still attend the other days (please indicate on registration form).

COST The cost is \$25 each participant. Scholarships are available.

FOOD

Meals and snacks will be provided each day. Dietary needs or allergies should be listed on the permission slip/indemnity form.

RELIGIOUS SERVICES

Mass will be offered daily. Campers will also have an opportunity to pray the Liturgy of the Hours, the rosary, and attend Eucharistic Adoration.

WHAT TO WEAR/BRING

Comfortable clothing/sneakers for outdoor activities, sun block, bug spray, allergy or prescribed medication, rosary, a water bottle, toiletries, bathing suit and extra towel (bedding provided). A more extensive list will be sent to those who are registered several weeks before the camp.

QUO VADIS CAMPAMENTO DE VERANO 2021

Quo Vadis es un campamento para Jovenes - Muchachos católicos de secundaria (desde los que ingresan al noveno grado hasta los que acaban de terminar el último año) para profundizar su fe, aprender más sobre las vocaciones y discernir mejor el llamado de Dios en sus vidas. Es un tiempo de recreación, compañerismo y oración. Sacerdotes y seminaristas de toda la Diócesis de Providence estarán presentes para dirigir conversaciones y ofrecer charlas de testimonios. Las actividades incluirán oración, misa diaria, recreación (juegos / deportes), discusiones grupales, charlas de testimonios, curso de desafío y más. Tendremos acceso a las instalaciones del seminario y a los dormitorios (camas, ropa de cama y almohadas incluidas), así como a los hermosos terrenos del seminario donde se llevarán a cabo las actividades al aire libre. Si un participante se perdiera un día o una parte de un día del retiro, aún puede asistir los otros días (indíquelo en el formulario de registro).

COSTO - El costo es de \$ 25 por participante. Hay becas disponibles.

COMIDA - Se proporcionarán comidas y refrigerios todos los días. Las necesidades dietéticas o las alergias deben indicarse en el formulario de autorización / indemnización.

SERVICIOS RELIGIOSOS- Se ofrecerá misa todos los días. Los campistas también tendrán la oportunidad de rezar la Liturgia de las Horas, el rosario y asistir a la Adoración Eucarística.
