

### GOSPEL - MK 10:46-52

As Jesus was leaving Jericho with his disciples and a sizable crowd, Bartimaeus, a blind man, the son of Timaeus, sat by the roadside begging. On hearing that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, son of David, have pity on me." And many rebuked him, telling him to be silent. But he kept calling out all the more, "Son of David, have pity on me." Jesus stopped and said, "Call him." So they called the blind man, saying to him, "Take courage; get up, Jesus is calling you." He threw aside his cloak, sprang up, and came to Jesus. Jesus said to him in reply, "What do you want me to do for you?" The blind man replied to him, "Master, I want to see." Jesus told him, "Go your way; your faith has saved you." Immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way.

## SISTER'S MARK ON MARK

Sister Helen's first assignment as a new teacher was 34 third graders! She loved them all, but there was 'something special' about Mark, even if he was a bit of a rogue. When he played tricks on his friends, she would publicly scold him, but always with a hidden smile. The following year she was assigned to Junior High Math, and so it was six years before Mark and his pals appeared before her again. My, was he grown-up and handsome, showing leadership qualities beyond his years! One Friday the class was completing a week-long project that had caused considerable frustration to both teacher and students. They all - but especially Mark - were so edgy and irritable with one another that she decided she had to do something about it. She stopped the project in mid-stream, and told each of them to spend the rest of the day writing the nicest thing they could about each of their classmates. On completion, they handed in their papers, and she spent the weekend compiling lists for each of them of what others had written. On Monday, each got two sheets of paper saying what the other students had said about him or her. The papers were never mentioned again, though she had the distinct feeling for some time that her students gained a deeper appreciation for one another because of the experience. Years later, Mark was killed in Vietnam! In grief, Sister Helen joined some of his classmates in a Funeral Mass, and the burial that followed. Tearfully she sprinkled his casket with holy water at the invitation of the priest. Quietly a soldier told her that Mark had spoken of her a lot. Later at lunch, Mark's father gathered with sister and his friends from school and announced: "There's something I want you all to see. This was found on Mark when he was killed." He opened Mark's billfold, and there - taped, folded and refolded many times - was the list of good things each of his classmates had said about him in the ninth grade. Sometimes you just never know how we are the bearers of light to others!

## MARCA DE LA HERMANA EN MARCA

¡La primera asignación de la hermana Helen como maestra nueva fue de 34 estudiantes de tercer grado! Los amaba a todos, pero había "algo especial" en Mark, incluso si era un poco pícaro. Cuando jugaba una mala pasada a sus amigos, ella lo regañaba públicamente, pero siempre con una sonrisa oculta. Al año siguiente fue asignada a la secundaria de matemáticas, por lo que pasaron seis años antes de que Mark y sus amigos aparecieran nuevamente ante ella. ¡Vaya, era un adulto y guapo, mostrando cualidades de liderazgo más allá de sus años! Un viernes, la clase estaba completando un proyecto de una semana que había causado una frustración considerable tanto al maestro como a los estudiantes. Todos, pero especialmente Mark, estaban tan nerviosos e irritables entre ellos que decidió que tenía que hacer algo al respecto. Detuvo el proyecto a mitad de camino y les dijo a cada uno de ellos que pasaran el resto del día escribiendo lo mejor que pudieran sobre cada uno de sus compañeros de clase. Al finalizar, entregaron sus papeles y ella pasó el fin de semana compilando listas para cada uno de ellos de lo que otros habían escrito. El lunes, cada uno recibió dos hojas de papel que decían lo que los otros estudiantes habían dicho sobre él o ella. Los artículos nunca se volvieron a mencionar, aunque durante algún tiempo tuvo la clara sensación de que sus alumnos se apreciaban más profundamente gracias a la experiencia. ¡Años más tarde, Mark fue asesinado en Vietnam! Con dolor, la hermana Helen se unió a algunos de sus compañeros de clase en una misa fúnebre y el entierro que siguió. Con lágrimas en los ojos, roció su ataúd con agua bendita por invitación del sacerdote. En voz baja, un soldado le dijo que Mark había hablado mucho de ella. Más tarde, durante el almuerzo, el padre de Mark se reunió con su hermana y sus amigos de la escuela y anunció: "Hay algo que quiero que todos vean. Esto se encontró en Mark cuando lo mataron". Abrió la billetera de Mark y allí, pegada, doblada y doblada muchas veces, estaba la lista de cosas buenas que cada uno de sus compañeros de clase había dicho sobre él en noveno grado. ¡A veces nunca se sabe cómo somos los portadores de luz para los demás!

**St. Patrick Academy  
Adopt-a-Student Program  
2021 - 2022**

In Academic year 2021-22, St. Patrick Academy will serve 84 students, the majority of which reside in Rhode Island's urban core of Providence, Pawtucket and Central Falls. Others come from the urban rim cities and towns including Cranston, North Providence, Johnston and East Providence.



70% of our students are of Hispanic heritage; this includes immigrants from the Caribbean, Mexico and Central and South America.

23% are of African American heritage; and 7% come from a variety of ethnic heritages.

70% of our students speak more than one language at home, including Spanish, French, Portuguese, Haitian Creole, and Cape Verdean Creole.

76% of our families meet the federal poverty guidelines for free and reduced-price lunches under the National School Lunch Program.

54% of our students live in single parent/guardian households and face serious challenges in the communities where they live. They deserve a safe and caring school environment in order to thrive spiritually, personally, and academically.

Many are the first in their family to pursue a college education. 99% of SPA seniors graduate and 100% of our graduates have been accepted to two or four year college/university programs or military service.

NATURE'S IMMUNE MESSENGERS

When I was about nine years old, I witnessed the birth of new foal. It was important for the newborn foal to get a bellyful of colostrum because it contained mom's immune memory and more. Little did I realize that much later, I would do research on colostral transfer factors.

Nature has empowered the immune systems of all higher animals with the gift of immune memory. Without it, each time our body experienced a threat, the entire system would have to work from scratch to mount an immune response. New immune responses take time, and microbial health threats exploit the time lag if they can.

In 1949, Dr. H. Sherwood Lawrence discovered that the contents of immune cells, when harvested and injected into another person, could transfer immune memory. The observation amazed Dr. Lawrence so much that he named the molecule transfer factor.

Transfer factors are small, unique polypeptides that encode the identity of a microbe in 3D. They create a unique pattern, like a footprint in the sand.
