





THE WORD OF GOD

LA PALABRA DE DIOS

GOSPEL - MK 10:17-30

As Jesus was setting out on a journey, a man ran up, knelt down before him, and asked him, "Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus answered him, "Why do you call me good? No one is good but God alone. You know the commandments: You shall not kill; you shall not commit adultery; you shall not steal; you shall not bear false witness; you shall not defraud; honor your father and your mother."

He replied and said to him, "Teacher, all of these I have observed from my youth." Jesus, looking at him, loved him and said to him, "You are lacking in one thing. Go, sell what you have, and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me." At that statement his face fell, and he went away sad, for he had many possessions. Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "How hard it is for those who have wealth to enter the kingdom of God!" The disciples were amazed at his words. So Jesus again said to them in reply, "Children, how hard it is to enter the kingdom of God! It is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for one who is rich to enter the kingdom of God." They were exceedingly astonished and said among themselves, "Then who can be saved?" Jesus looked at them and said, "For human beings it is impossible, but not for God. All things are possible for God." Peter began to say to him, "We have given up everything and followed you." Jesus said, "Amen, I say to you, there is no one who has given up house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands for my sake and for the sake of the gospel who will not receive a hundred times more now in this present age: houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions, and eternal life in the age to come.

EVANGELIO- MC MC 10:17-30

En aquel tiempo, cuando salía Jesús al camino, se le acercó corriendo un hombre, se arrodilló ante él y le preguntó: "Maestro bueno, ¿qué debo hacer para alcanzar la vida eterna?" Jesús le contestó: "¿Por qué me llamas bueno? Nadie es bueno sino sólo Dios. Ya sabes los mandamientos: No matarás, no cometerás adulterio, no robarás, no levantarás falso testimonio, no cometerás fraudes, honrarás a tu padre y a tu madre". Entonces él le contestó: "Maestro, todo eso lo he cumplido desde muy joven". Jesús lo miró con amor y le dijo: "Sólo una cosa te falta: Ve y vende lo que tienes, da el dinero a los pobres y así tendrás un tesoro en los cielos. Despues, ven y sígueme". Pero al oír estas palabras, el hombre se tristeó y se fue apesadumbrado, porque tenía muchos bienes. Jesús, mirando a su alrededor, dijo entonces a sus discípulos: "¡Qué difícil les va a ser a los ricos entrar en el Reino de Dios!" Los discípulos quedaron sorprendidos ante estas palabras; pero Jesús insistió: "Hijitos, ¡qué difícil es para los que confían en las riquezas, entrar en el Reino de Dios! Más fácil le es a un camello pasar por el ojo de una aguja, que a un rico entrar en el Reino de Dios". Ellos se asombraron todavía más y comentaban entre sí: "Entonces, ¿quién puede salvase?" Jesús, mirándolos fijamente, les dijo: "Es imposible para los hombres, mas no para Dios. Para Dios todo es posible". Entonces Pedro le dijo a Jesús: "Señor, ya ves que nosotros lo hemos dejado todo para seguirte". Jesús le respondió: "Yo les aseguro: Nadie que haya dejado casa, o hermanos o hermanas, o padre o madre, o hijos o tierras, por mí y por el Evangelio, dejará de recibir, en esta vida, el ciento por uno en casas, hermanos, hermanas, madres, hijos y tierras, junto con persecuciones, y en el otro mundo, la vida eterna".

THE GOOD SHEPHERD PSALM

There's a story told about a young boy growing up in a small village in Ireland at the turn of this century. He came from a poor family, and so opportunities were limited. His dream was that one day he would be a Shakesperean actor, and he practiced often the famous passages from poems and plays.

The old pastor in the village saw the young man's talent and potential, and so he headed the drive to help him with his education in college and acting school. Eventually, they young man did indeed make it to the London and New York stage, and he became famous.

On a journey to England from the United States on one occasion, he stopped off in Ireland and visited his old village. The natives turned out in force to see him, their local boy-made-good, the one who had brought celebrity status in a special way to his tiny out-of-the-way place of birth. They danced and sang and joked in the village center.

Then someone asked the actor if he would perform for them! He consented to recite Psalm 23 on one condition. He would do so only if the old pastor who had helped him so much would do the same. And so it was agreed.

He began: "The Lord is my Shepherd. There is nothing I shall want. In verdant pastures he gives me repose. Near restful waters he leads me. He refreshes my soul." His command of English was perfect! His intonations, gestures, timing were without flaw. On completion, he received a prolonged and thunderous standing ovation.

Then it was the old priest's turn! Bent over, he faced the crowd. "The Lord is my shepherd," he started "there is nothing I shall want ...". His voice was weak. He hesitated. He muttered here and there. But as he proceeded, the atmosphere began to change. A different kind of hush came over the crowd. Awe! Reverence! Almost worship! Some found it difficult to hold back tears.

When he finished, there was no applause. In fact, you could hear a pin drop. That's when the famous one spoke up and said: "You see, friends, that's the difference. I know the Good Shepherd Psalm. Father knows the Good Shepherd."

El anciano pastor de la aldea vio el talento y el potencial del joven, por lo que se dirigió a la campaña para ayudarlo con su educación en la universidad y la escuela de actuación. Finalmente, el joven llegó a los escenarios de Londres y Nueva York, y se hizo famoso.

En un viaje a Inglaterra desde los Estados Unidos en una ocasión, se detuvo en Irlanda y visitó su antiguo pueblo. Los nativos acudieron en masa a verlo a él, el chico local hecho bueno, el que había traído el estatus de celebridad de una manera especial a su pequeño y apartado lugar de nacimiento. Bailaron, cantaron y bromearon en el centro del pueblo.

Pero a medida que avanzaba, la atmósfera comenzó a cambiar. Un tipo diferente de silencio se apoderó de la multitud. ¡Temor! ¡Reverencia! ¡Casi adoración! A algunos les resultó difícil contener las lágrimas.

Cuando terminó, no hubo aplausos. De hecho, se podía oír caer un alfiler. Fue entonces cuando el famoso habló y dijo: "Miren, amigos, esa es la diferencia. Yo conozco el Salmo del Buen Pastor. El Padre conoce al Buen Pastor".

NATURE'S IMMUNE MESSENGERS

When I was about nine years old, I witnessed the birth of new foal. It was important for the newborn foal to get a bellyful of colostrum because it contained mom's immune memory and more. Little did I realize that much later, I would do research on colostral transfer factors.

Nature has empowered the immune systems of all higher animals with the gift of immune memory. Without it, each time our body experienced a threat, the entire system would have to work from scratch to mount an immune response. New immune responses take time, and microbial health threats exploit the time lag if they can.

In 1949, Dr. H. Sherwood Lawrence discovered that the contents of immune cells, when harvested and injected into another person, could transfer immune memory. The observation amazed Dr. Lawrence so much that he named the molecule transfer factor.

Transfer factors are small, unique polypeptides that encode the identity of a microbe in 3D. They create a unique pattern, like a footprint in the sand.
