GOSPEL - MK 9:30-37

Jesus and his disciples left from there and began a journey through Galilee, but he did not wish anyone to know about it. He was teaching his disciples and telling them, "The Son of Man is to be handed over to men and they will kill him, and three days after his death the Son of Man will rise." But they did not understand the saying, and they were afraid to question him. They came to Capernaum and, once inside the house, he began to ask them, "What were you arguing about on the way?" But they remained silent. They had been discussing among themselves on the way who was the greatest. Then he sat down, called the Twelve, and said to them, "If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all." Taking a child, he placed it in their midst, and putting his arms around it, he said to them, "Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me; and whoever receives me, receives not me but the One who sent me."

EVANGELIO- MC 9:30-37

Llegaron a Cafarnaúm, y una vez en casa, les preguntó: "¿De qué discutían por el camino?" Pero ellos se quedaron callados, porque en el camino habían discutido sobre quién de ellos era el más importante. Entonces Jesús se sentó, llamó a los Doce y les dijo: "Si alguno quiere ser el primero, que sea el último de todos y el servidor de todos".

Después, tomando a un niño, lo puso en medio de ellos, lo abrazó y les dijo: "El que reciba en mi nombre a uno de estos niños, a mí me recibe. Y el que me reciba a mí, no me recibe a mí, sino a aquel que me ha enviado".

THE NAVAL OFFICER

The young man was on leave for only two weeks. He was eager to see his parents, his friends, but one in particular, - that very special girl. His plans didn't include a visit to old Mrs. Malone in the nursing home, which his mother had asked him to do. She had been a neighbor, yes, but not exactly close, and so - "Come on, Mom. I can't run around to everyone. This is my leave!"

His better nature finally prevailed, so he went, and this is what he wrote much later in life:

"I found her in a room with three other elderly people. I was in uniform, of course, but when she caught sight of me, you would think I was Jesus Christ. She wept for joy, hugged me and showed me off to her friends. And I can still see her waving feebly that last goodbye. No, I really had not known her very well; I did this basically to please my mother. But I was appalled that I might not have done it. It struck me that had I not gone, God would some day call me to account for denying old Mrs. Malone that much joy by simply coming through the door."

EL OFICIAL NAVAL

El joven estuvo en licencia por solo dos semanas. Estaba ansioso por ver a sus padres, a sus amigos, pero a una en particular, esa chica tan especial. Sus planes no incluían una visita a la anciana señora Malone en el asilo de ancianos, que su madre le había pedido que hiciera. Ella había sido una vecina, sí, pero no exactamente cercana, y entonces - "Vamos, mamá. No puedo correr y ver a todos. ¡Esta es mi licencia!"

Su mejor naturaleza finalmente prevaleció, así que fue, y esto es lo que escribió mucho más tarde en su vida:

"La encontré en una habitación con otras tres personas mayores. Yo vestía uniforme, por supuesto, pero cuando me veía, pensaría que era Jesucristo. Pues, Lloró de alegría, me abrazó y me mostró. amigos. Y todavía puedo verla saludando débilmente ese último adiós. No, la verdad es que no la conocía muy bien; hice esto básicamente para complacer a mi madre. Pero estaba horrorizado de no haberlo hecho. Me di cuenta de que si no hubiera ido, algún día Dios me llamaría para rendir cuentas por haberle negado a la señora mayor, Malone tanto gozo simplemente entrando por la puerta".

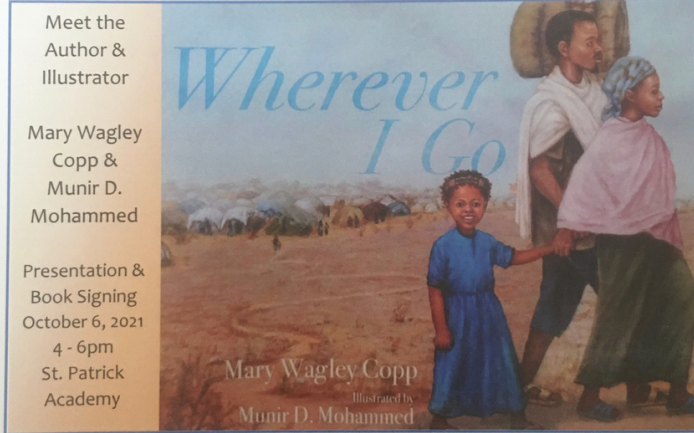

Adopt-a-Student Program

2021 - 2022

In Academic year 2021-22, St. Patrick Academy will serve 84 students, the majority of which reside in Rhode Island's urban core of Providence, Pawtucket and Central Falls. Others come from the urban rim cities and towns including Cranston, North Providence, Johnston and East Providence.



70% of our students are of Hispanic heritage; this includes immigrants from the Caribbean, Mexico and Central and South America.

23% are of African American heritage; and 7% come from a variety of ethnic heritages.

70% of our students speak more than one language at home, including Spanish, French, Portuguese, Haitian Creole, and Cape Verdean Creole.

76% of our families meet the federal poverty guidelines for free and reduced-price lunches under the National School Lunch Program.

54% of our students live in single parent/guardian households and face serious challenges in the communities where they live. They deserve a safe and caring school environment in order to thrive spiritually, personally, and academically.

Many are the first in their family to pursue a college education. 99% of SPA seniors graduate and 100% of our graduates have been accepted to two or four year college/university programs or military service.



What does it cost to educate each student at SPA?

The cost to educate one student at St. Patrick Academy is \$12,800, and no family is asked to pay more for tuition than they can afford. On average our families pay 10% or \$1,280 annually. **We rely on the generosity of our friends and supporters to bridge the gap.**

You can make a positive impact on the lives of deserving young women and men who want an affordable, quality, Catholic college-preparatory education. Our students really strive to succeed - let's give them the best of what life can offer by providing them with a safe and exemplary high school experience. 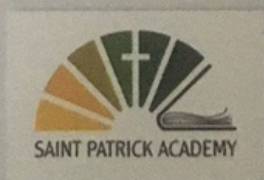
How do I adopt a student?

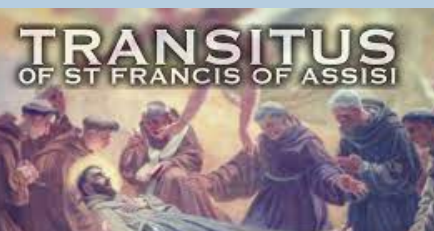
