From the Desk of our Seminarian, Matthew Boni:

Dear parishioners,

I want to write to you this week to thank you for your efforts to support priestly vocations, especially in the Diocese of Providence. I have seen your constant prayers for an increase in vocations during the Masses and in your own prayers. As a seminarian, I have been inspired by the great attendance at the holy hours that happen on the first Wednesday of each month with the purpose of asking that God may send us more priests. Also, several people have told me that they would be very happy if one of their children became a priest someday. How great it is when parents offer their child to God on the day of his birth and are ready to accept God's will if He is calling him to the priesthood! It is clear that the people of Saint Patrick sincerely want more priests for the Church, more laborers for the harvest. Today, I want to assure you that God hears these prayers and longings, and there is evidence of this. This year, God has given us eight new seminarians who will begin the process of formation in the seminary in a few weeks. I have spent some time with these men, and it is interesting that they all have a different story. Some are 18 and about to start college. Others have just graduated from college, and others are older and have worked for several years. This diversity is a reminder to us that God answers our prayers and calls men to the priesthood in his own time. It is even very possible that God is calling men from our parish to serve him as a priest. May we never forget that prayer is necessary and powerful, especially when it comes to priestly vocations. May God bless you for all that you have done in support of vocations.

Reverend and dear Monsignor/Father:

I am very sorry to announce that the **Annual Wedding Anniversary Mass**, scheduled for the Cathedral of SS. Peter and Paul on Sunday, September 27th, will have to be cancelled. The Wedding Anniversary Mass is one of the largest and most joyful events in the life of the Diocese, but the need to cancel is unavoidable. Every year the Mass draws a large number of couples (and their families), to the Cathedral for Holy Mass and a reception, but many of the attendees are advanced in age. The risks to the health of the participants would be significant.

It is certainly our hope and our expectation that the Wedding Anniversary Mass will be scheduled again next year.

In the meantime, we are still eager to recognize those couples in the Diocese of Providence who are celebrating significant wedding anniversaries this year. If you are aware of couples in your parish who are celebrating special anniversaries, (e.g., 25, 40, 50, 60 years or more), and would like them to be recognized, please send their names and mailing addresses and the number of years they are celebrating to my office, via regular mail or email, and I will be very happy to send them a personal letter and a signed certificate.

Thank you for your attention to this announcement and for your continuing pastoral care of your people. Together we look forward to and pray for that day when our normal pastoral activities can resume without disruption or fear.

Gospel MT 14:22-33

After he had fed the people, Jesus made the disciples get into a boat and precede him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowds. After doing so, he went up on the mountain by himself to pray. When it was evening, he was there alone. Meanwhile the boat, already a few miles offshore, was being tossed about by the waves, for the wind was against it. During the fourth watch of the night, he came toward them walking on the sea. When the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were terrified. "It is a ghost," they said, and they cried out in fear. At once Jesus spoke to them, "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." Peter said to him in reply, "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water." He said, "Come." Peter got out of the boat and began to walk on the water toward Jesus. But when he saw how strong the wind was, he became frightened; and, beginning to sink, he cried out, "Lord, save me!" Immediately Jesus stretched out his hand and caught Peter, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" After they got into the boat, the wind died down. Those who were in the boat did him homage, saying, "Truly, you are the Son of God."



XIX Domingo En Tiempo Ordinario Evangelio, Mt 14, 22-33

En aquel tiempo, inmediatamente después de la multiplicación de los panes, Jesús hizo que sus discípulos subieran a la barca y se dirigieran a la otra orilla, mientras él despedía a la gente. Después de despedirla, subió al monte a solas para orar. Llegada la noche, estaba él solo allí. Entretanto, la barca iba ya muy lejos de la costa, y las olas la sacudían, porque el viento era contrario. A la madrugada, Jesús fue hacia ellos, caminando sobre el agua. Los discípulos, al verlo andar sobre el agua, se espantaron, y decían: "¡Es un fantasma!" Y daban gritos de terror. Pero Jesús les dijo enseguida: "Tranquilízense y no teman. Soy yo". Entonces le dijo Pedro: "Señor, si eres tú, mándame ir a ti caminando sobre el agua". Jesús le contestó: "Ven". Pedro bajó de la barca y comenzó a caminar sobre el agua hacia Jesús; pero al sentir la fuerza del viento, le entró miedo, comenzó a hundirse y gritó: "¡Sálvame, Señor!" Inmediatamente Jesús le tendió la mano, lo sostuvo y le dijo: "Hombre de poca fe, ¿por qué dudaste?" En cuanto subieron a la barca, el viento se calmó. Los que estaban en la barca se postraron ante Jesús diciendo: "Verdaderamente tú eres el Hijo de Dios" ..

THE SEA CAPTAIN

There was once a sea captain who in his retirement skippered a boat, taking day trippers to the Shetland Islands off the coast of Scotland. On one trip the boat was full of young people. They laughed at the old captain when they saw him saying a prayer before setting out, for the day was fine and the sea calm.

But when out at sea a storm suddenly blew up, and the boat began to pitch violently, the terrified passengers came to the captain and asked him to join them in prayer. His solemn reply was: "I say my prayers when it is calm. When it's rough, I attend to my ship".

There is a lesson here for us. If we cannot or will not seek God in the quiet moments of our lives, we are not likely to find him when trouble strikes. We are more likely to panic. But if we have learnt to seek him and trust him in the quiet moments, then most certainly we will find him when the going gets rough.
