For those wanting a more interactive experience, Collaborative Painting is another unique way to bring art to your live event!

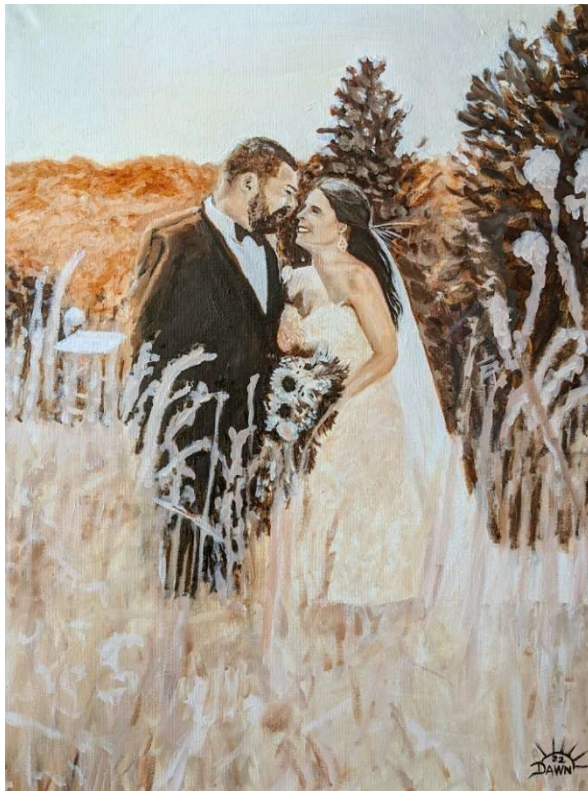


Photo Painting
