2024 APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Cape Area Pilots Association, Inc. (CAPA) offers several scholarships each year up to \$3,500. These scholarships are for students seeking aviation careers enrolling in higher education institutions specializing in aviation learning.

To be eligible for these scholarships, the applicant must:

- Be a resident of Cape Cod, Massachusetts.
- A United States citizen.
- A high school senior, graduate, attending an aviation college or university leading to
 a Bachelors or Associates degree in an aviation related course of study, OR
 employed in an aviation related field during which you are attempting to enhance
 your aviation job skills through course work at a trade, technical school, junior
 college, college, or university.

To submit an application:

- 1. Complete the Cape Area Pilots Scholarship application form. (attached)
- 2. First letter of recommendation; from a teacher, professor, instructor, guidance counselor, or employer.
- 3. Second letter of recommendation; from a non-relative attesting to your character and knows you well as an individual.
- 4. Personal letter from the applicant. This letter should include, but is not limited to, your reason for selecting an aviation career path, personal interests, aviation related activities and what they mean to you; what employment you intend to pursue, and extracurricular activities, hobbies and interests. Discuss how you would use the scholarship proceeds to attain your aviation goals.
- 5. Copy of your most current transcript.
