


# CACTUS IN BLOOM





approximately 1½ hours

# **BRUSHES: 3**

34" Flat No. 2 Round No. 12 Bright

# **COLORS: 8**

Burnt Umber Deep Yellow Green Oxide Mars Black Neon Pink Phthalo Green Phthalo Red Titanium White

TIP: Use hand-held hairdryer to speed up drying times.





### TRANSFER PATTERN

 Trace and transfer pattern onto canvas. Refer to methodology for detailed instructions.



# STEP ONE

- Use ¾" Flat Brush to mix (6) parts Titanium White with (1) part Phthalo Red. Use mix to paint background above table line. Rinse brush.
- Use No. 12 Bright Brush to mix

   (2) parts Burnt Umber with small amount of water. Use mix to paint table using long, horizontal strokes. Rinse brush
- Use No. 12 Bright Brush and Burnt Umber to create shadow under and to right side of flower pot. Rinse brush.



## **STEP TWO**

- Use No. 12 Bright Brush to mix

   (1) part Green Oxide with small amount of Burnt Umber. Use mix to paint cactus. Rinse brush.
- Use No. 12 Bright Brush to mix

   (1) part Phthalo Green with (1) part
   Burnt Umber. Use mix to shade right sides of cactus. Rinse brush.
- Use No. 12 Bright Brush to mix

   (1) part Deep Yellow with (1) part
   Titanium White. Use mix to highlight
   left side of cactus. Rinse brush.



### STEP THREE

- Use No. 2 Round Brush to mix

   (1) part Phthalo Red with (1) part
   Neon Pink. Use mix to paint flowers.
   Save mix for next bullet. Rinse brush. Use No. 2 Round Brush and
   Titanium White to highlight flowers.
   Rinse brush.
- Use No. 12 Bright Brush to add

   (1) part Phthalo Red to mix from bullet 1. Use new mix to paint flower pot. Rinse brush.
- Use No. 12 Bright Brush to mix

   (2) parts Phthalo Red with (1) part
   Burnt Umber. Use mix to shade
   bottom and right side of flower
   pot. Rinse brush.
- Use No. 12 Bright Brush and Titanium White to dry-brush highlights to left side of flower pot. Refer to methodology for detailed instructions. Rinse brush.



## STEP FOUR

 Use No. 2 Round Brush to mix

 (2) parts Burnt Umber with small amount of Mars Black. Use mix to paint spots and thorns on cactus and centers of flowers, and to dab on dirt in flower pot. Rinse brush.
