



SIMPLE SLOTH





approximately 1½ hours

BRUSHES: 3

No. 2 Round No. 8 Bright No. 12 Bright

COLORS: 7

Bright Red Chrome Orange Chrome Yellow Cobalt Blue Green Oxide Mars Black Titanium White

TIP: Use hand-held hairdryer to speed up drying times.

TRANSFER PATTERN

 Trace and transfer pattern onto canvas. Refer to methodology for detailed instructions



STEP ONE

 Use No. 12 Bright Brush with Mars Black to paint background. Rinse brush.



STEP TWO

 Use No. 8 Bright Brush to mix (1½) parts Titanium White with (1) part Bright Red. Use mix to paint main sloth body. Rinse brush.



STEP THREE

- Use No. 8 Bright Brush to mix (1½) parts Titanium White with very small amount of Bright Red. Use mix to paint remaining body sections, Rinse brush.
- Use No. 2 Round Brush and Titanium White to paint sloth's face. Rinse brush.



STEP FOUR

 Use No. 8 Bright Brush to mix

 (1) part Chrome Yellow with small amount of Green Oxide. Use mix to paint leaves and stem. Save mix for STEP EIGHT, bullet 2.

 Rinse brush.



STEP FIVE

 Use No. 12 Bright Brush and Green Oxide to highlight center of leaves and top edge of stem, Rinse brush.



STEP SIX

Use No. 8 Bright Brush to mix

 (1) part Titanium White with
 (½) part Cobalt Blue. Use mix to paint remaining leaves. Save mix for STEP EIGHT, bullet 1.

 Rinse brush.



STEP SEVEN

 Use No. 12 Bright Brush and Cobalt Blue to highlight center of leaves. Rinse brush.



STEP EIGHT

- Use No. 8 Bright Brush and mix from STEP SIX to paint veins on green leaves. Rinse brush.
- Use No. 8 Bright Brush and mix from STEP FOUR to paint veins on blue leaves. Rinse brush.



STEP NINE

 Use No. 2 Round Brush and Mars Black to paint eyes, mouth, and nose, Rinse brush.



STEP TEN

- Use No. 8 Bright Brush to mix

 (1) part Chrome Orange with
 (1) part Bright Red. Use mix to paint hash marks on sloth.
- Use No. 2 Round Brush and Titanium White to paint claws and touch up eyes, if necessary. Rinse brush.
