

2023 OSCS Points Advancement System

For 2023 We will use the following Points advancement system for all Classes.

We will also rename the beginner classes to D class only.

The OSCS and track owners have the authority to advance a rider at any time under the correct circumstances. He may or may not carry his points depending upon the situation.

1st Place 10 points

2nd Place 7 points

3rd Place 5 points

4th Place 3 points

5th Place 2 points

Any rider reaching 35 points, or a class win will have to move up into the next ranking class. The following riders will have to advance to the next skill class, if a rider wants, he can advance himself to the next skill class but will not be able to go back down.
