

Where can I complete community service hours in Tarrant County?

Community service hours are usually required as a condition of probation or diversion program or as part of a plea negotiation packet or a memo agreement with a prosecutor or Court. It is important to confirm that the community service hours that you are completing are acceptable as part of your packet or memo agreement or probation. A registered charitable/non-profit organization is a universally acceptable choice. Prior to beginning community service hours, confirm your chosen location with your attorney or probation officer. Completing community service that is not approved could result in repeating the community service hours. It is also important to keep a record of any community service hours complete and obtaining a signature from a person at your agency/charity, as well as their title and contact information, to confirm your completion of the hours. Use of a community service completion log is advisable.
