

Tarrant County Substance Abuse Evaluation Information and Location List

You can be ordered to complete a Substance Abuse Evaluation (SAE) if you have been charged with or convicted of a Driving While Intoxicated offense or a Drug related offense. A Substance Abuse Evaluation can be ordered by the Court to determine if treatment or educational programs will be required as a term of probation. Your attorney may also request that you complete a Substance Abuse Evaluation as part of a mitigation or plea negotiation packet with the goal of obtaining a more favorable resolution to your case.

A Substance Abuse Evaluation generally involves the following:

1. Arrest History
2. Alcohol and Drug Use History
3. Completion of Alcohol and Drug Screening Instruments/Assessments
4. Interview with a Professional Counselor
5. DSM-5 Classification/Diagnosis
6. Treatment Recommendations

The below Substance Abuse Evaluation providers are approved by the Tarrant County Probation Department. If you desire to complete your Substance Abuse Evaluation at another agency, check with your attorney or probation officer first to be sure the agency is approved by the Court or Probation Department.
