

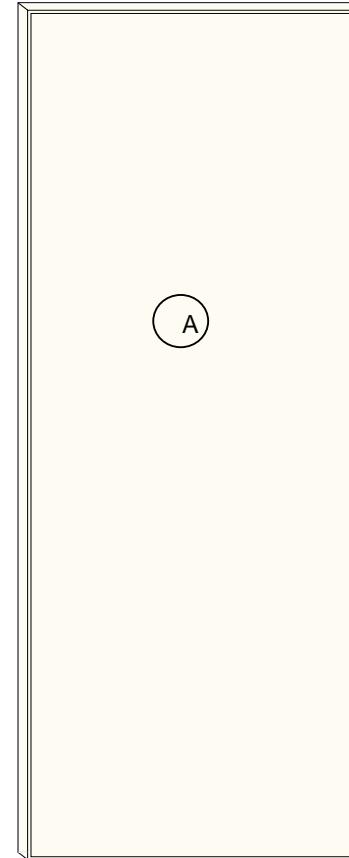

DSWV or DSWM SLATWALL PANEL

*** Please read and review all instructions prior to starting assembly ***

- Step One:** Unpack end panel(s). Mounting hardware is not included.
- Step Two:** Determine where on the existing metal shelving you will be mounting the panel(s). Determine the length of wood screw required based on the metal plate, tube or bracket that you have to mount through before reaching the wood panel's). The panel(s) are no more the 1" Thick. Measure panel and metal together to determine length of wood screw. You will need to purchase the appropriate length of hardware for your installation.
- Step Three:** Mount end panels from the top down. Aligning any top brackets or canopies first. Adjustable glides on metal shelving may be exposed once panel is attached. Uneven floors and adjustable leveling glides on the shelving are not taken into consideration when panels are sized.

Furniture Care Recommendations from the nation's leading furniture manufacturers

- 1.) Dust frequently.
- 2.) Use a quality furniture polish approximately once a month to lessen your chance of expensive refinishing jobs.
- 3.) Clean up spills immediately. Use a blotting action rather than a wiping action.
- 4.) For cleaning use a soft, lint-free absorbent cloth.
- 5.) Avoid placing furniture in direct sun light.
- 6.) Avoid extremes in room humidity. Too high or too low humidity can cause wood to warp or glue lines to fail.
- 7.) Avoid extreme changes in temperature. Arrange furniture away from radiators, registers and air-conditioning units.
- 8.) Rotate accessories on furniture so they do not sit in the same place all the time.
- 9.) Do not place plastic or rubber objects on a wood finish-their ingredients react with those of the finish.
- 10.) Use pads, cloth or felt to protect the furniture surface from plastic, rubber, hot dishes, beverages, bookends, flowerpots and vases.
- 11.) Lift objects-do not drag them across the furniture surface.
- 12.) Never use silicone or petroleum distillate polishes.
