1. Identify current energy supplier. Identify current energy charge. Rate negotiated by city is \$0.0434 per kWh until May 2022

2. To get out of current supplier call number listed on bill. Be aware that an early termination fee may apply. This often takes a couple of billing cycles to be completed.

3. Call 1-877-353-0162 and ask to opt-in with the City of Kenton's Electric Aggregation Program. The rate should be \$0.0434 per kWh until May 2022.
