NEW BUSINESS:

ORDINANCE NO. 21-018, 1ST READING, TITLE ONLY; AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE MATERIAL TERMS OF THE ONE OHIO SUBDIVISION SETTLEMENT PURSUANT TO THE ONE OHIO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AND CONSISTENT WITH THE TERMS OF THE JULY 21, 2021 NATIONAL OPIOID SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Althausen: John will be able to provide more information on this at our meeting on August 8th at 7PM as he has read through the entire packet of information & legislation. What I can tell you is we received notice late last week that the legislation has to be passed by next Friday...cities all over are scrambling trying to get this in place. I know Delphos sat in special session for 2 hours waiting on the legislation...the more municipalities that agree with this legislation the higher the dollar amount will be in the pool...pharmaceuticals will have more time and the municipalities agree not to sue later. Some of the larger communities might go that direction though. Does anyone have any questions? Okay, if there are no objections to passing this to a 2nd reading on Sunday at 7PM, we're adjourned.
