

The Suzanne and Richard Bretherick Memorial Dance Scholarship

This scholarship is given by The Suzanne and Richard Bretherick Memorial Fund & is 1 of 3 scholarships (different criteria apply), given in memory of Suzanne and Richard Bretherick. The Bretherick Memorial Dance Scholarship honors the Bretherick's commitment to be the best and most supportive grandparents. They embraced dance, even though they had no experience with it. They followed their granddaughters and their chosen sport, wherever that took them. They were also known for their unconditional support for the entire team.

Eligibility

The scholarship will be a combination of academic, merit, financial need, & talent. Awarded to a High School Senior pursuing an undergraduate or technical college degree. Students will be required to be enrolled, full-time, in an accredited college/university. (Full time is to be defined by the college/university).

This scholarship will be allocated for the purpose of tuition, room and board, and books for the 2021 - 2022 school year.

Applicants may major or attend a technical program, in any field.

Requirements:

1. Attended Collierville High School, 4 years.
2. Grade point average of 3.0 or higher
3. Show financial need/ provided after submitting your FAFSA.
4. Copy of High School Transcript
5. College Acceptance letter
6. Resume of activities and leadership roles, community service, church service, and / or any work experience.
7. Letter of recommendations
8. Parents'/Guardians' name(s) and occupation(s)
9. List all scholarships you have applied and have been awarded.
10. ACT/SAT score

Scholarship submission must include:

1. Proof of well-rounded dance training for AT LEAST 10 years, which shall consist of: A MINIMUM of AT LEAST (3) of the following disciplines, participating in 8+ hours a week (throughout the school year): **Tap, Ballet, Jazz, Lyrical, Pointe Contemporary**
2. Student Aid Report/Estimated Family Contribution report provided after submitting your FAFSA.
3. Collierville High School transcript with a 3.0 minimum GPA.
4. Letters of Recommendation. Your application requires at least (no more than 4, total, please):

ONE letter of recommendation from a CURRENT or FORMER Teacher, for THIS student, outlining why you are a good choice for this scholarship.

AND

ONE letter of recommendation from a community or church leader, for THIS student, who has participated as this student's mentor / counselor and / or leader.

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RECOMMENDER, please outline what *exactly* the student has participated in. As well as, why it is that you believe they should receive the scholarship.

Letters of recommendation need to be submitted online by the **RECOMMENDER**, using email link provided:
