

The Suzanne and Richard Bretherick Memorial Football Scholarship

This scholarship is given by The Suzanne and Richard Bretherick Memorial Fund & is 1 of 3 scholarships (different criteria apply), given in memory of Suzanne and Richard Bretherick. The Brethericks were longtime supporters of Collierville High School football and were 30-year members of the Collierville Kickoff Club. Suzanne & Richard started with Collierville Football when their oldest son, Ricky, was entering Collierville High School and began playing on the football team. Their youngest child, Matthew, later followed suit. Suzanne served multiple terms as a board member and was often charged with buying and working the concession stands. Richard could also be found in the concession stands prepping for the games. While his health allowed, he enjoyed cooking hamburgers and hotdogs for the many fans. He was also a wiz at the popcorn machine! Once he had helped set up, he would move to the stands for the game. They supported team after team, regardless of age, long after their sons had graduated. You could find them at the fields, throughout the week, 6th grade - 12th. If there was a game...they were there! Their three kids, 2 sons and 1 daughter, as well as their 2 granddaughters have each attended Collierville Schools for all 12 years (the youngest is a junior, now).

Eligibility

The scholarship will be a combination of academic, merit, financial need, & talent. It will be awarded to a Collierville High School senior pursuing an undergraduate or technical college degree. Students will be required to be enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited college/university. (Full time is to be defined by the college/university).

This scholarship will be allocated for the purpose of tuition, room and board, and books for the 2021 - 2022 school year.

Applicants may major or attend a technical program, in any field.

Requirements:

1. Attended Collierville High School for 4 years.
2. Financial need. Student Aid Report provided after submitting your FAFSA
3. Minimum grade point average of 3.0.
4. The student should be well rounded with CONSISTENT EVIDENCE working /volunteering among their Community / Church participating ACTIVELY.
5. Letters of Recommendation: Your application requires **at least** (no more than 4, total, please):
 - a. **ONE** letter of recommendation from a CURRENT or FORMER Teacher outlining why you are a good choice for this scholarship.
 - b. **ONE** letter of recommendation from a community or church leader who has participated as this student's mentor/counselor and/or leader.
 - c. **ONE** letter of recommendation from a Collierville football coach.
6. **RECOMMENDER**, please outline what *exactly* the student has participated in. As well as, why it is that you believe they should receive the scholarship.
 - a. Letters of recommendation need to be submitted online by the **RECOMMENDER**, using email link provided:
