

The Suzanne and Richard Bretherick Memorial Magnolia Elementary Scholarship

This scholarship is given by The Suzanne and Richard Bretherick Memorial Fund & it is 1 of 3 scholarships (different criteria apply), given in memory of Suzanne and Richard Bretherick. Mrs Bretherick taught school at Magnolia Elementary School, in Memphis Tennessee. She taught both 1st and 2nd grade at Magnolia Elementary, over a span of 34 years. She devoted her life to education. Suzanne never gave a second thought to leaving "her kids." One of the greatest joys in her life was hearing that "her kids" were succeeding, achieving, and excelling at life!

Eligibility

The scholarship will be a combination of academic, merit, financial need, & talent. Awarded to a High School Senior pursuing an undergraduate or technical college degree. Students will be required to be enrolled, full-time, in an accredited college/university. (Full time is to be defined by the college/university).

This scholarship will be allocated for the purpose of tuition, room and board, and books for the 2021 - 2022 school year.

Applicants may major or attend a technical program, in any field.

Requirements:

1. Attended Magnolia Elementary School for at least 4 out of the 6 possible years.
2. Financial need. Student Aid Report provided after submitting your FAFSA
3. Minimum grade point average of 3.0.
4. The student should be well rounded with CONSISTENT EVIDENCE working /volunteering among their Community / Church participating ACTIVELY.
5. Letters of Recommendation: Your application requires **at least** (no more than 4, total, please):

ONE letter of recommendation from a CURRENT or FORMER Teacher, for THIS student, outlining why you are a good choice for this scholarship.

AND

ONE letter of recommendation from a community or church leader, for THIS student, who has participated as this student's mentor / counselor and / or leader.

RECOMMENDER, please outline what *exactly* the student has participated in. As well as, why it is that you believe they should receive the scholarship.

Letters of recommendation need to be submitted online by the **RECOMMENDER**, using email link provided:
