Our mission is to provide services for families, and child victims and witnesses of domestic violence and or sexual abuse by providing holistic therapeutic services through Art Therapy.


Our Vision

Project Speak-Out

Project Speak Out is our outreach and advocacy program offered to partners in education, community, and faith-based sectors. We incorporate arts, wellness, and self-care in our customized workshops and trainings to fit your specific needs.

Creating Youth Voices for Change

9-week art series for middle and high school youth to explore and develop expressive arts, creativity, and social emotional skills. Annual groups offered in the spring and fall, and mobile summer session offered during the summer.

Direct Care Services

Empowering People-Inspiring Community (E.P.I.C)

E.P.I.C. is our holistic direct care program for children and adults. We provide DV/SA/MH therapy services, resiliency coaching, case management, parenting classes, and therapeutic support groups.

Bold Economic Advocacy (BEA)

Bold Economic Advocacy (BEA) is a 7 week financial wellness support group to assist adult survivors in regaining their financial independence.

Circle of Hope

Circle of Hope is an intensive support group for survivors of domestic violence and sexual abuse, or youth who are witnesses to trauma.




