## The National Exchange Club 2025 Dues Increase





Delegates at the 2025 National Convention will be asked to approve a minimal 10% dues increase, proposed by the National Board of Directors, as follows:

Active, Active honorary, At large, Active family, Business, and Collegiate Members: \$19.50 to \$21.50

Excel: \$12.00 to \$13.50

Honorary: \$8.00 to \$9.00

Additional family member: \$10.00 to \$11.00

Since the 50 cent dues increase approved in 2019, The National Exchange Club has cut costs and reduced staffing. Rising costs now necessitate a dues increase.

As a member focused non-profit, costs have dramatically increased as they have for everyone, both at home and in business. We have all seen costs rise at the grocery store, with memberships and activities, and other areas of life.

## We appreciate the careful consideration of members to approve this necessary increase.
