Bringing awareness while positively impacting our communities

In our past two Exchanging Ideas Zoom get-togethers, there has been quite a lot of dis-

cussion around our national project, the Prevention of Child Abuse, and how we may bring awareness this April.

In case you've missed these meetings, a lot of great ideas have been shared, so I will share a few here:

1. **Community Day/Picnic.** Bring the community out to a local park, have food available either as free will, or for a cost, and sell blue balloons (environmentally safe, please). Invite a speaker to address the group, and bring awareness to the prevention of child abuse, and why it is important. At a designated time, release the balloons. Exchange club members release white balloons for the children we have lost this past year.

2. **Blue Ribbon Sale.** Purchase paper blue ribbons from The National Exchange Club store and partner with local grocers, downtown businesses, and convenience stores to sell these ribbons on your behalf, and hang them up in the store. Include informa-



tion that can be distributed that shares an awareness message. Send volunteers into the store to help the store out while they are selling these (i.e. bagging, etc.).

3. 5k for the Prevention of Child Abuse. Everyone is eager to get out of their homes. Plan a 5k walk/run with your local Park & Rec. Bring in a speaker or a local prevention of child abuse center to talk about the importance of supporting parents in the prevention of child abuse. Have a few games for the kids, or place at a park, and bring in food vendors.

There were a lot more ideas, so please reach out to your nearest club and ask them what they did. If it makes sense logistically to join forces—even better! If you don't have a club near you, then we need to do something about that! Contact the Volunteer Field Representatives (VFRs) Katie, Sharon, or myself, and let us know that you'd like help building a neighboring club, so you can double your impact.

In this month's Exchangite newsletter you will find registration and awards information for our district convention, May 19-21, in Waterloo, Iowa. Our theme this year is, "Red, White, & 'Loo." The convention committee has done a great job pulling together what I believe will be our best convention yet!

The district winners will be announced at the District Convention in Waterloo, Iowal on May 20th.

The District Awards will include "The Exchangite of the Year", Rookie of the Year, Outstanding Club, Outstanding Club Bulletin, Outstanding Club Website and Outstanding Club Facebook Page. And this year we are reintroducing "The <u>All American</u> Volunteer of the Year". In addition, The <u>Exchangite Hall of Fame</u> <u>Award for</u> those members celebrating at least 25-year memberships and significant contributions to their clubs will be recognized. *PLEASE NOTE: It is strongly recommended that the nominees for the individual awards attend the District Convention Awards Banquet scheduled for May 20, 2023. It is also strongly recommended that a Club representative be in attendance for the club awards.

District Youth Awards will also be presented for "Youth of the Year" and "A.C.E. of the Year". These nominations are due to the District Awards Committee no later than <u>Saturday, April 15, 2023</u>. Please use the official nomination forms found on the National Exchange Club <u>website</u>, <u>www.nationalexchangeclub.org</u>. *PLEASE NOTE: The recipients of these awards are <u>required</u> to include a photo (head and shoulders) and <u>must be in Attendance at</u> the Lakes & Prairies District Exchange Convention <u>Youth Awards Lunch</u> scheduled for Saturday May 20, 2023.

The National Exchange Club offers an <u>additional Youth</u> Award called the *"Legacy Award"*. This award is a little different than the other youth awards. It recognizes high school students who are children or grandchildren of a current Exchange Club Member. Candidates will submit their original applications directly to The National Exchange Club Headquarters and a copy to the District Awards Committee. We will acknowledge our club nominees at the District Convention. The official nominations form is also located on The National Exchange Club <u>website</u>, <u>www.nationalexchangeclub.org</u>.

Thank you for taking the time to say thank you to our fellow Exchangites and recognizing them for their outstanding contributions to our clubs, communities, and our country.

EXCHANGITE OF THE YEAR AWARD – this award is given to an individual who has excelled in Exchange during the current 2022-2023 year. It includes efforts in membership, leadership, <u>volunteerism</u> and active participation in Exchange activities at all levels including District and National.

ROOKIE OF THE YEAR AWARD – this award is given to an individual who joined Exchange after July 1, 2021. It is awarded to an individual who has really stepped up to the plate as a <u>NEW</u> Exchangite. The criteria <u>is</u> the same as for the <u>Exchangite</u> of the Year but must fit within the less than two year membership date parameters.

<u>ALL AMERICAN VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR</u> – this award is given to an individual for their contributions at the club level in a <u>NON-Leadership</u> role. It is designed to recognize and acknowledge the multiple hours <u>and</u> <u>contributions</u> made toward club projects and programs, including regular attendance at club meetings and events. The nominee should not have served in a Leadership capacity and is considered the worker bee or the backbone of the club.

EXCHANGITE HALL OF FAME AWARD – this award is given to those individuals who have been a member of Exchange for a minimum of 25 years. It is based on the continuous contributions of the individual throughout the 25 plus years and includes all aspects of <u>Exchange</u>; club, district, and national. It is a Lifetime Achievement Award designed to recognize your fellow club members.

<u>OUTSTANDING CLUB AWARD</u> – criteria for this award include, but are not limited to, community service projects, Americanism projects. Youth projects, and Club projects involving Child Abuse Prevention, including all Fundraising efforts. Membership growth and retention are also key. The Award is a traveling Best Club Banner for your club to display at club meetings and events. The club will retain possession of the banner until the awards ceremony the following year. The club will also receive a Gift Card to the National Exchange Market.

<u>OUTSTANDING CLUB BULLETIN/NEWSLETTER AWARD</u> – choose five bulletins/newsletters that the club has printed between July <u>1st</u> 2022 and March 15th of 2023. Criteria is based on content; (does it include specific club information), is it balanced, promotes participation and significant news, and contains the appropriate Exchange logos; readability, and eye appeal. More specific criteria can be found on the National website – www.nationalexchangeclub.org

OUTSTANDING CLUB WEB-SITE AWARD – websites will be rated on the content, structure, visual design, and functionality. It follows much of the same guidelines as the Bulletin/Newsletter award.

<u>OUTSTANDING CLUB FACEBOOK PAGE</u> - Facebook pages will be rated on the content, visual design, functionality and <u>relevants</u> of the posts and outreach results in participation through Likes, Comments, Fundraising results etc.
