Today's organ music is based on the hymn tune "Laudate Dominum." The tune was written by C. Hubert Parry; the organ arrangement is by Charles Callahan. The tune is commonly used for the hymn "Sing Praise o the Lord," a metrical version of Psalm 149.

"Sing Praise to the Lord" is pure praise throughout all of its stanzas.

Sing praise to the Lord! Praise God in the height;

Rejoice in his word, you angels of light;

O heavens, adore him by whom you were made,

And worship before him in brightness arrayed.

This 1st stanza is followed by, "Sing praise...all you of new birth," then by "Sing praise...all things that give sound." It culminates with:

To him be outpoured all ages along;

For love in creation, for heaven restored,

For grace of salvation, sing praise to the Lord!
