

The Book of Hebrews: Faith in Practical Ways a sermon Series

It has been a rewarding endeavor to dive deeper into the book of Hebrews and explore its implications for our faith journey. To remind all of us, Hebrews consists of three main sections or themes:

Instruction (Hebrews 1-4): This section emphasizes **the supremacy of Christ** as the Son of God and highlights the importance of faith and obedience. It teaches about the significance of Christ's revelation and His role as our High Priest.

Institution (Hebrews 5-10): This part discusses the establishment of a new covenant through Christ, who serves as the ultimate High Priest. It explains the significance of His sacrifice and how it fulfills and surpasses the Old Testament sacrificial system. Important points include:

Exhortation (Hebrews 11-13): The final section serves as an encouragement and call to action for believers. It includes examples of faith and practical applications for living a Christian life.

The book of Hebrews guides readers through the understanding of faith in Christ, the establishment of the new covenant, and the call to live out that faith in practical ways.

As we conclude the first section about instructions, we will begin exploring the institution piece of the book in the Month of October 2024.
