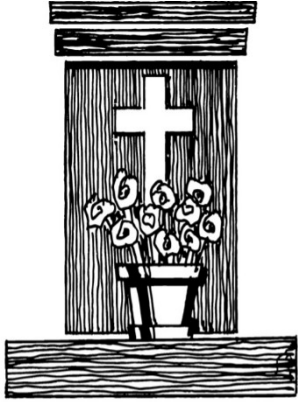


Sermon Titles for January 2025

Sunday, January 5th, 2025

Philippians 3:1-14 — *"Gathered in Grace"*

As we enter a new year, this passage reminds us to rejoice in our relationship with Christ and to press forward toward our heavenly calling. This empowers us to strive for the future as God's chosen, gathered in community to support one another in our spiritual journeys.

Sunday, January 12th

Luke 3:22-23 — *"Jesus' Baptism and Our Mission"*

Luke 3 reflects on Jesus' baptism as an important event that marked the beginning of His public ministry. It reminds us of our own baptisms and how they signify a commitment to God's call and mission. It helps us embrace our own roles in sharing the Gospel and serving others as we step into this new year, empowered by the Holy Spirit.

Sunday, January 19th

Psalms 36:5-10 — *"In the Shadow of His Wings"*

This message focuses on God's protection and how we can find refuge in Him as we face the uncertainties of life. It explores the themes of trusting in God's faithfulness, seeking His righteousness, and being nourished by His goodness as we grow in our faith.

Sunday, January 26th

Nehemiah 8:1-3 — *"Rediscovering Our Roots"*

Nehemiah's reading of the Law serves as a reminder of the importance of returning to God's Word—the Bible. This calls us to mirror our spiritual roots as an approach to strengthening our faith and community in the new year and beyond.

Sunday, February 2, 2025

Isaiah 43:18-19 — *"Beyond Yesterday"*

God is always at work in our lives, guiding us to be open to the new opportunities and transformations He has in store for us.
