

Sermon Titles—September 2025

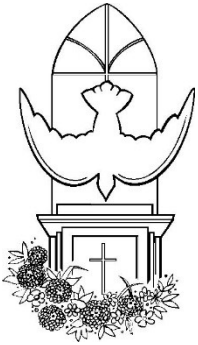
Sermon titles and a summary

This month, we will continue exploring the Book of Joshua, highlighting the importance of courage in the Christian faith. As we dive deeper into this book, we uncover lessons that emphasize obedience, resilience, and trust, reflecting our spiritual journey with God.

Sunday, September 7th, 2025

Joshua 7:1-5 — *“The Cost of Disobedience”*

Joshua 7 reminds us of the importance of obedience to God and the impact of sin (Romans 6:26). It calls for vigilance, both individually and collectively, as we strive to align our actions with God's will, fostering a community that honors and follows God faithfully.



Sunday, September 14th, 2025

Joshua 8:30-35 — *“Covenant Renewal”*

The event on the twin mountains of Ebal and Gerizim reflects covenant renewal in the life of faith. It represents communal worship, encouraging us in our commitments to faith and to our community (Deuteronomy 27:4-8).

Sunday, September 21st

Joshua 9:1-15 — *“Beware of Deception”*

This story describes the dangers of deception and the necessity of seeking divine wisdom in our choices. It encourages believers to remain vigilant and discerning, ensuring that we stay true to God amid potential distractions and deceptions.

Sunday, August 28th

Joshua 10:1-15 — *“The Light That Never Fails”*

The miracle of the Sun standing still illustrates the reliability of God in moments of uncertainty. It invites us to trust in God's provision and power, fostering a deeper faith in His ability to light our path even in the darkest circumstances of our lives (*Proverbs 4:18*).
