The Parable of the Prodigal Son

There is nothing in the entire Scripture that is more capable of stirring up contrition in even the most hardened heart than the parable of the Prodigal Son. I once encountered a convict in New South Wales who showed no signs of repentance in any other aspect of his life, yet whenever he heard a sermon or an analysis of this parable, he would burst into uncontrollable tears. I witnessed this on numerous occasions. Truly, the one who spoke this parable understood the innermost depths of human nature." This parable is the pinnacle among parables, a gospel within the gospel, a reflection of humanity, a simple yet profound portrayal of human downfall and redemption.
