2019 was a challenging yet successful year for RRWES!

The challenge hit us when two valuable Board Members had to resign due to job relocation and job growth. Our Vice-Chair announced her job relocation a month prior to our inaugural "We Rise Recharge Women's Empowerment Conference" and the other member ended her term, the end of December. We are thankful we were able to fill the vacancies and have a full board as of the writing of this report.

We are happy we met our 2019 Sustainable Fundraising Goals! As we continue to use the Benevon Fundraising Model, we held our first Free Lunch Fundraising Ask Event and added 3 new donors to our Multiple Year Giving Society adding an additional \$100 a month which allowed us to end 2019 with a positive bottom-line.

We were also thrilled to launch our first full-day, "We Rise-Recharge Women's Empowerment Conference" on Oct. 26, 2019 at the Detroit Southfield Marriott Hotel. The conference included vendors and awesome workshops, facilitators and speakers and was a success! Many women are inquiring about our next one!

Another goal we established was to do more networking and collaborations with other organizations. I am excited that we have begun planning with other Foundations, and Organizations, a one-day program on Mental Health Awareness for adults and youth during Mental Health Awareness Month, in collaboration with the Charles H. Wright Museum of African American History in Detroit. The program is scheduled to take place May 14, 2020 at the Museum.

We held our 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual "Daughters of the Gospel" program in April 2019 at Ashland Theological Seminary which helped many female preachers release their burdens, cares and challenges of ministry and refresh with renewed hope, and courage to stay on the journey.

In summary, we are building a following of Women & Girls through various strategies including a strong social media presence.

Our successful workshops would not be possible without our hardworking, dedicated Board, Donors, Supporters & Partners.

We truly appreciate all that you do! We are looking forward to a great 2020 as we continue to provide relevant programming that continues our mission of improving the Mental, Spiritual, and Emotional health of Women and Girls.
